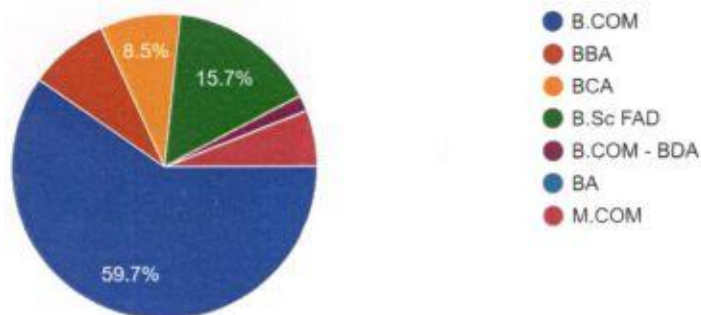

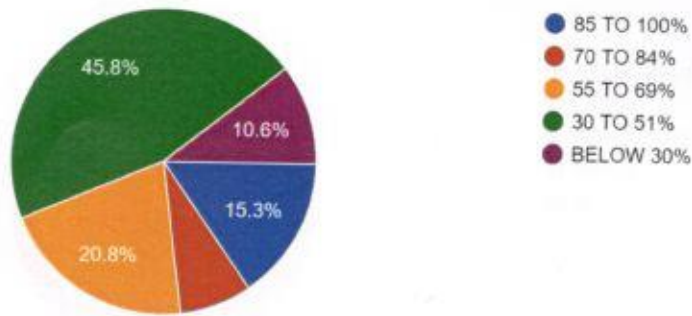

It can be deduced that the majority of them—59.7% of them were B.Com students, followed by 15.7% of B.Sc. Fad students, 8.5% of BCA students, 8.5% of BBA students, 5.9% of M.Com students, and the remaining are B.Com BDA students. This indicates that the college has a strong B.Com programme.

1. HOW MUCH OF THE SYLLABUS WAS COVERED IN CLASS

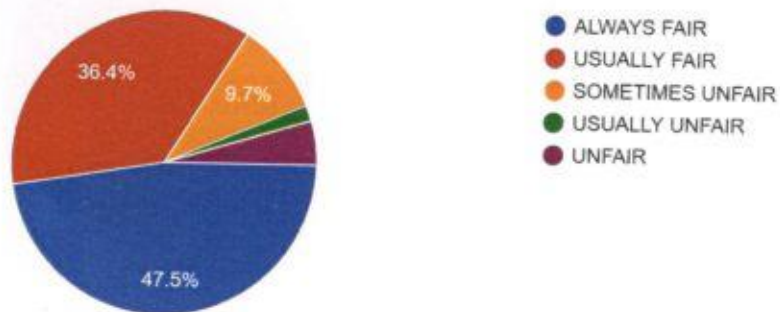

The syllabus was covered in class at the time of the responses taken by the students with respect to different classes, majority 45.80% of the teachers had covered 30 to 51% of the syllabus, 20.80% of the teachers had covered 55-69% of the syllabus, 15.3% of the teachers had covered 85-100% syllabus, 10.60% of the teachers had covered below 30% of the syllabus and remaining teachers had covered 70-84% of syllabus. From it is clear that syllabus will be covered within the given time frame.

2. FAIRNESS OF THE INTERNAL EVALUATION PROCESS BY THE TEACHERS

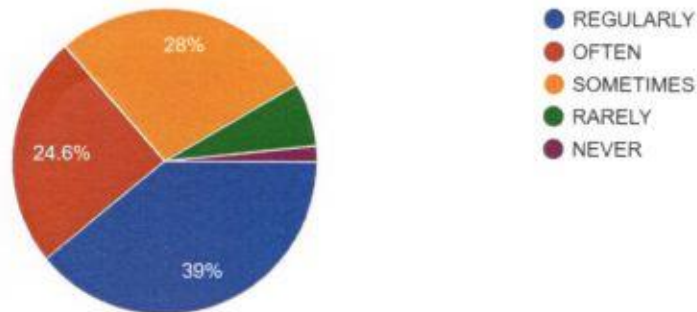

Majority Regarding the internal review procedure by the teachers, 47.5% of the students think it is always fair, 36.4% say it is mostly fair, 9.7% say it is occasionally fair, 4.9% say it is unfair, and the remainder say it is typically unjust. 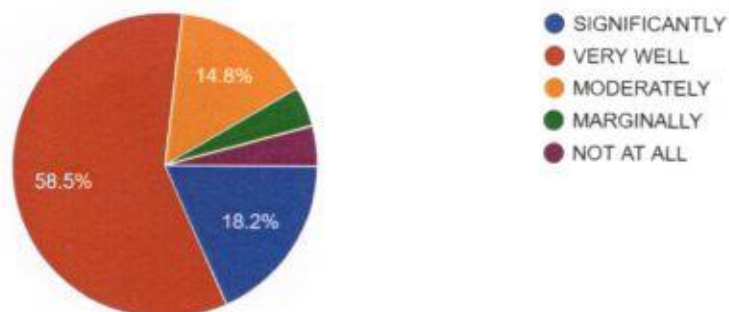

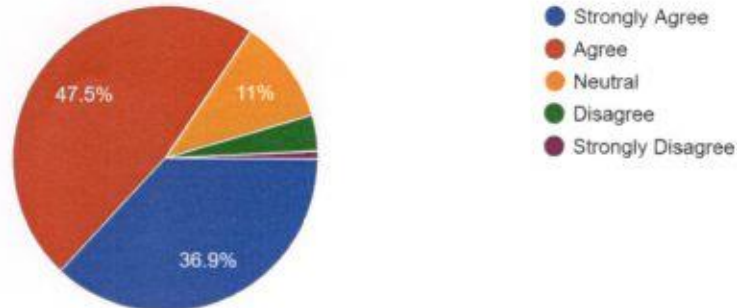

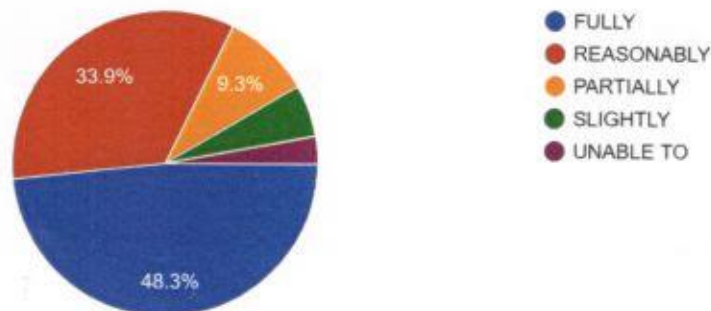

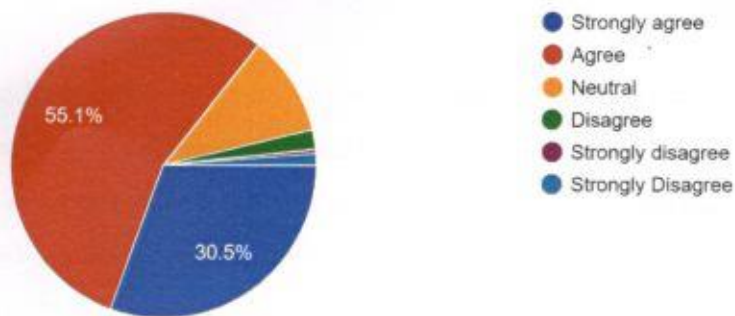
