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Workshop On “Effective Study Skills And Efficiency Techniques

Finally he worked out problems on payback period. Accounting rate of return, average rate of return and also problems on net present value and session ended by advising the students about their future.

The platform automates most of the manual work of all the people involved in the colleges and gives them freedom to concentrate only on giving best possible education to their students. Mrs Shilpa from ERP pupilpod conducted the session how to log in to the app through credentials sent through text messages to their respective mobile number to all individual faculty the app has some features like

Individual profile:- Individual faculty profile has to be updated in this features like name, designation, age, gender, DOB, year of joining, etc.

Faculty Attendance: - Everyday updating of attendance like login and logout of the faculties as per college timing.

Leave application: - Direct application of leave through this feature which directly goes to the principal for approval.

Student attendance: - updating of student's attendance for every class through this feature which later can be collected as data for attendance purposes.

My text: - any notification or SMS can be sent to faculty members by the college like holidays, government circulars etc.

My circulars: - circulars can be updated on this feature about internals test, exam dates, classes of online and offline etc.

The above features were explained and taught how to update individual profile of faculty and also gave a clear idea on how to update the faculty attendance like login and logout details as per the college time, updating student attendance and applying of leaves through App.

The session was conducted for 1hr and 20 faculty members took part in the session and gained hands-on experience in handling the portal practically
