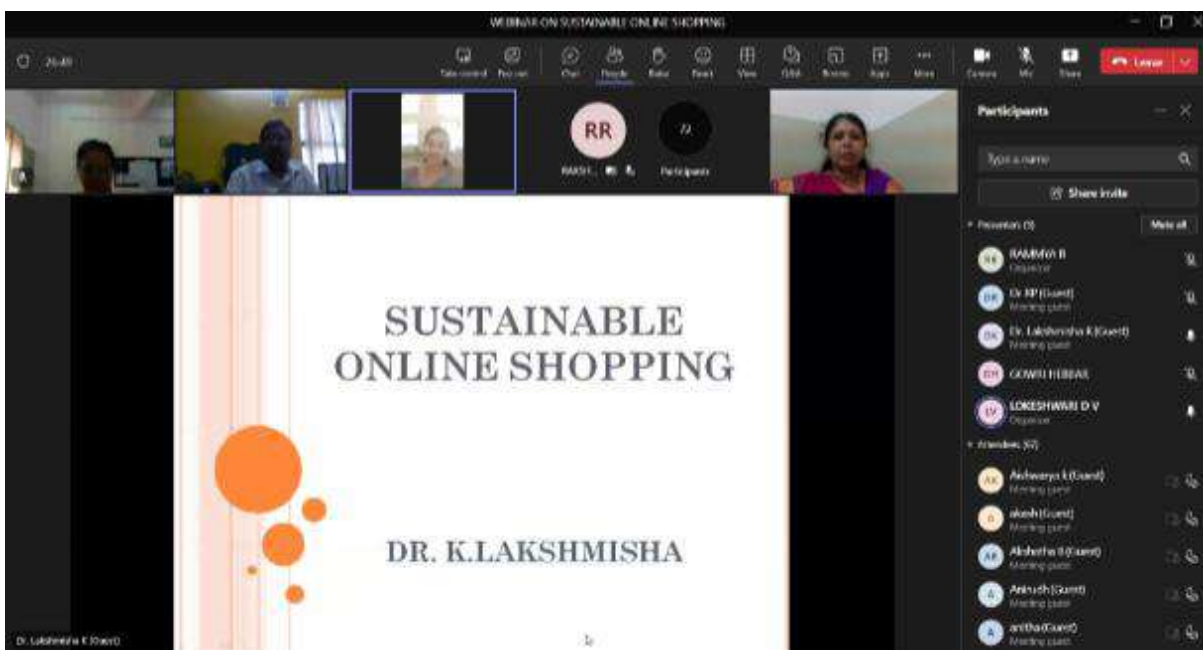
OFF CAMPUS DRIVE-BigHaat

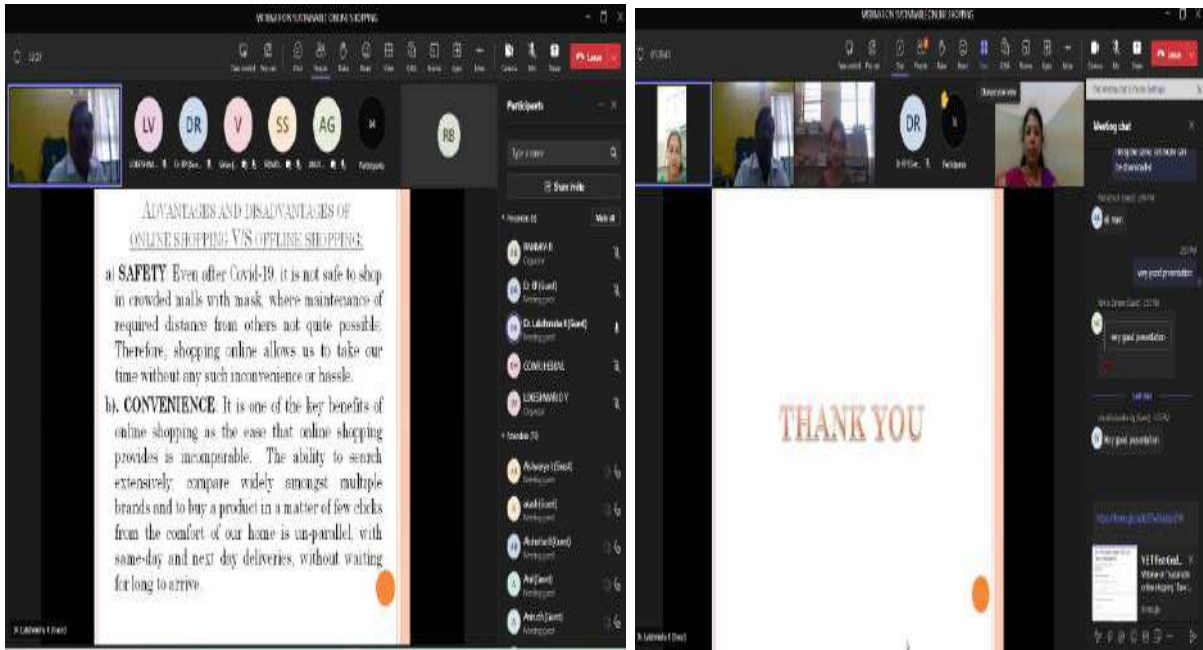

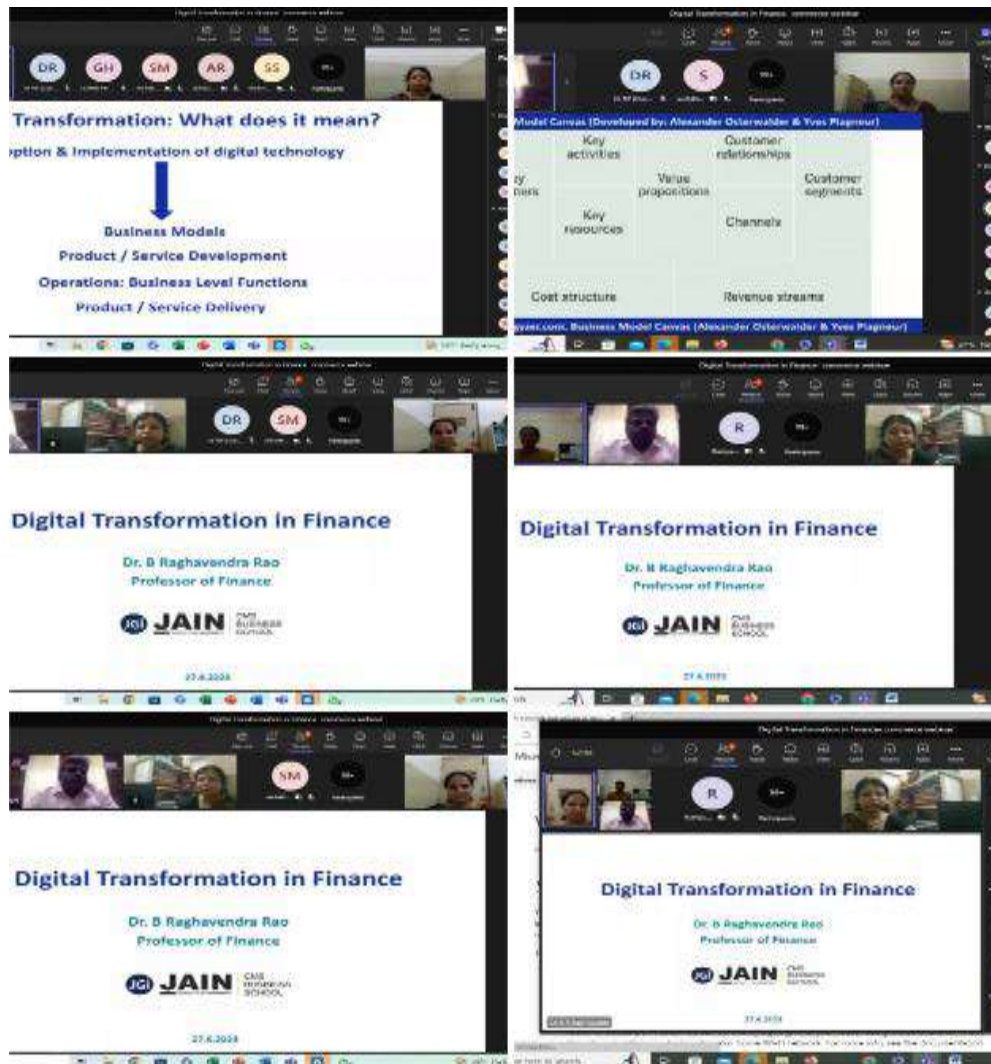
“Competitive Exam’s on Banking in Association with T.I.M.E”

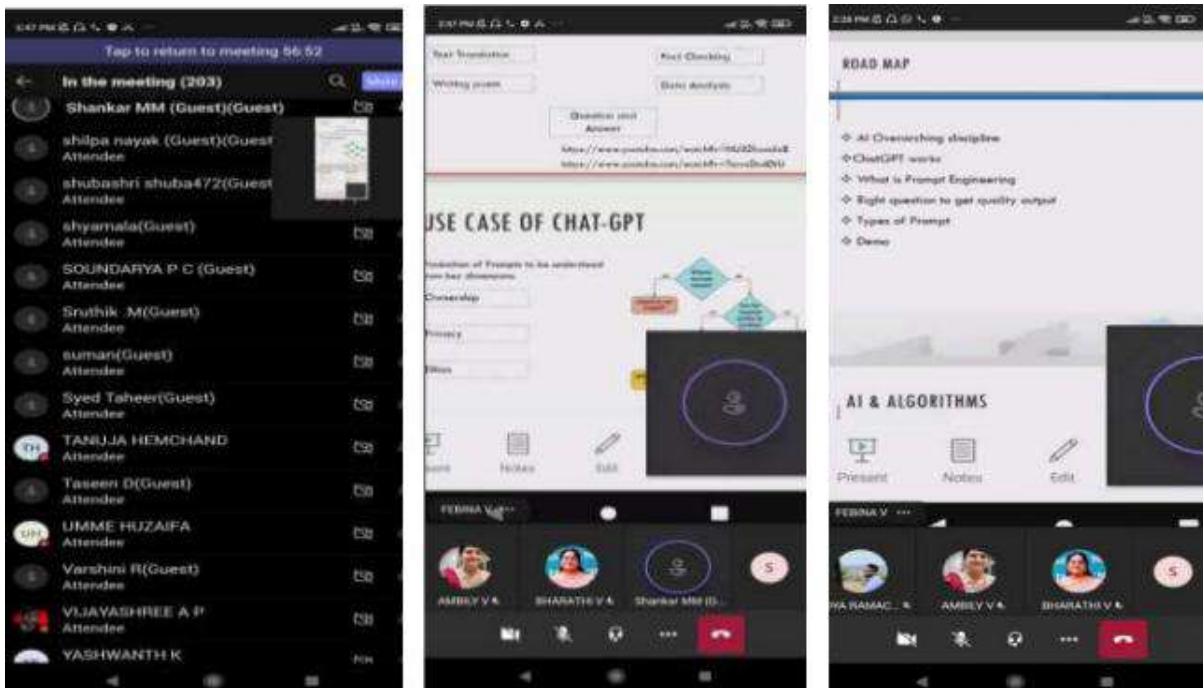
STORY WRITING COMPETITION

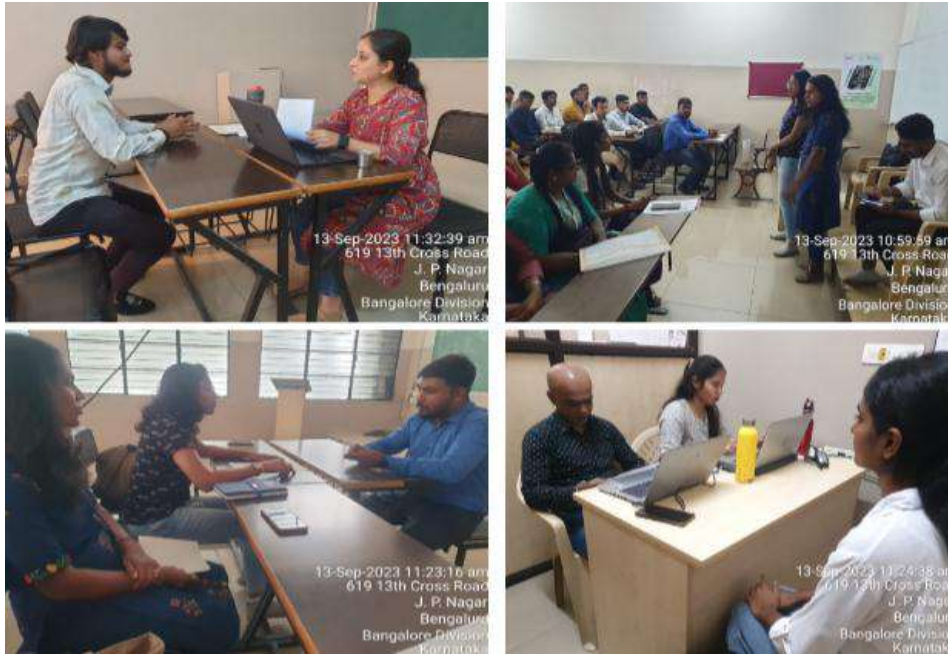
Seminar on “Personality Development, Grooming, Menstrual Hygiene and Body Language”

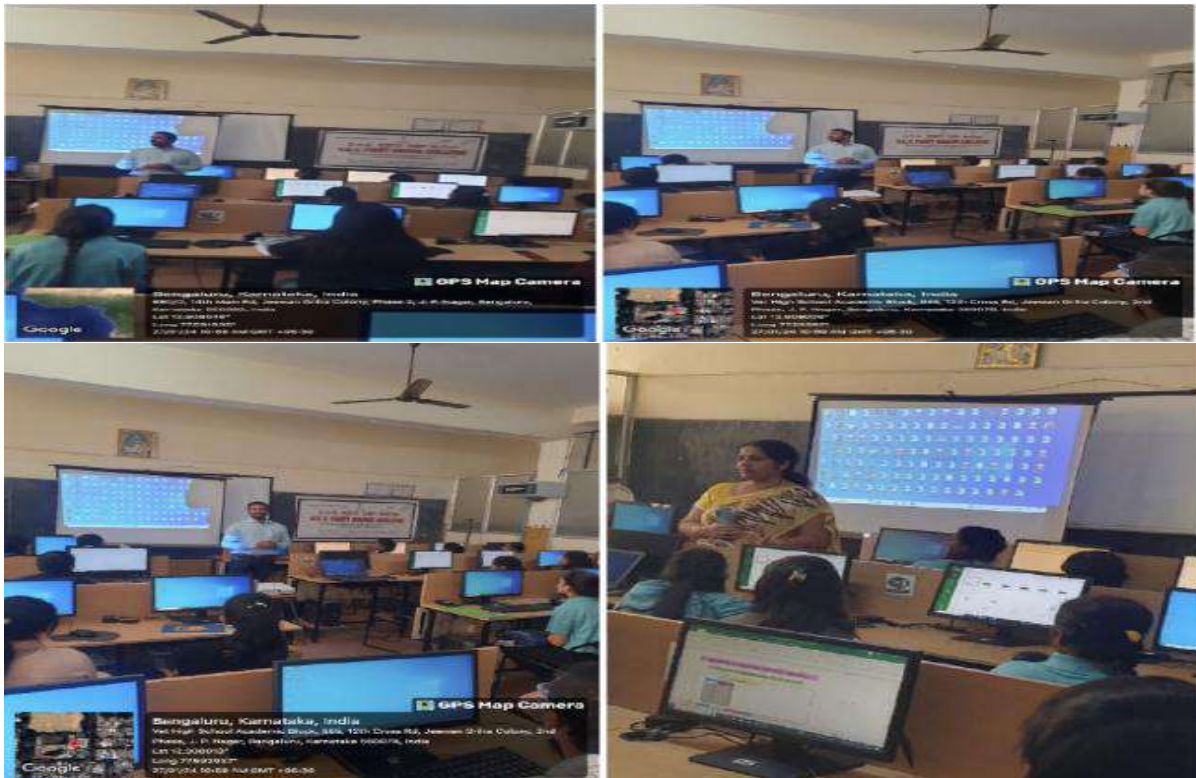
INVESTITURE CEREMONY

activities were well attended, and winners were recognized for their participation.



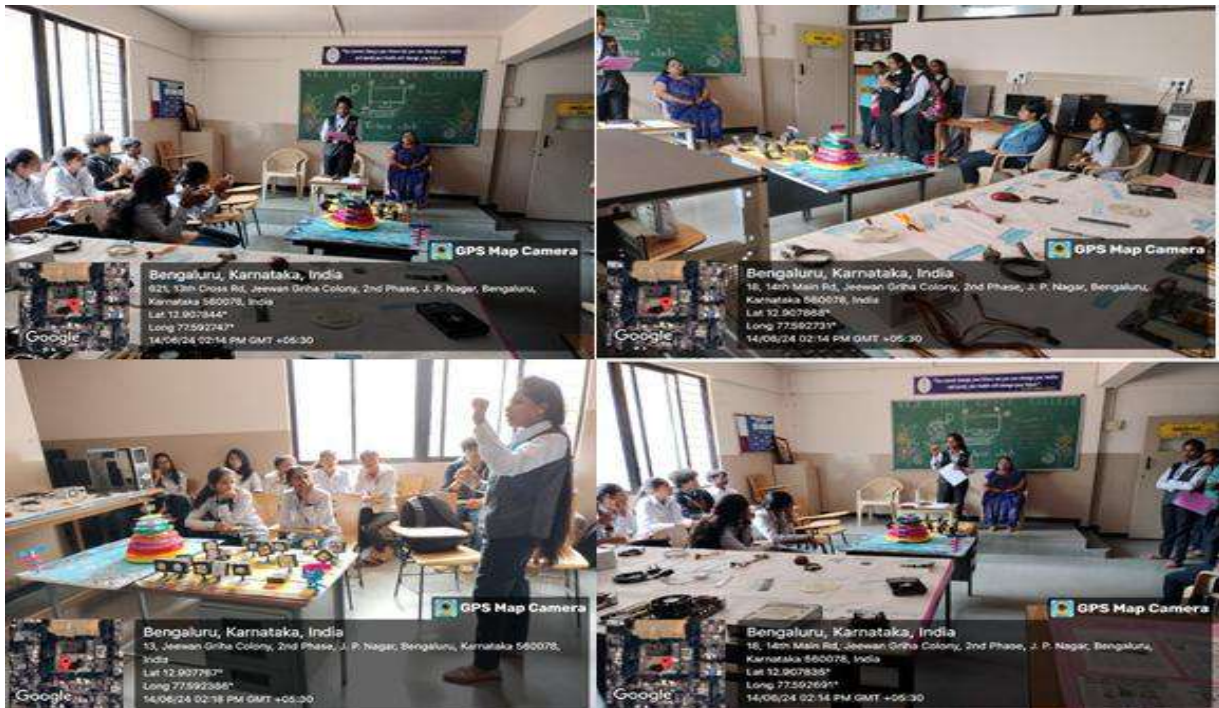
BUSINESS LAB
