VISIT TO CSTRI, BANGALORE.

In August 2018, a visit was organised to Central Silk Technological Research Institute, Bangalore. CSTRI is the only research institute in the country dedicated to the Research & Developmental activities related to silk technology. The visit to CSTRI was very beneficial as the textile engineers and the scientists conducted sessions related to silk manufacturing, pre and post-treatments, product development, which has helped the students to understand the subject better, through CSTRI laboratories, which were showing the live processes.

KSIC VISIT

Students of II, IV and VI SEM B.Sc-Fashion & Apparel Designing and four staff coordinators visited KSIC (Karnataka Silk Industries Corporation) Silk Factory and Showroom at Mysore on 05.04.2018. KSIC is the only organization in the country commanding the entire gamut of silk production right from reeling of cocoons to the weaving of pure silk fabric of various shades and designs. KSIC uses only high quality pure natural silk and 100% pure gold zari. During this session, students interacted with the workers very effectively, particularly about the chemicals used in the processing of silk fabric before dyeing, the dyeing process, finishing & warehousing of silk sarees. Students have gained practical knowledge during this visit.

VISIT TO CHANNAPATNA CRAFTS PARK

Channapatna Crafts Park is India's first crafts park and is located at Channapatna in Karnataka. Channapatna is a crafts cluster of over 3000 traditional artisans engaged in the production of lacquer ware. Spread over 14 acres of land, the Park has a sophisticated common facility Service Centre with state-of-the-art wood working machines. Shilpa Trust is one of the companies currently operating within the Park. The company is engaged in the production of fashion accessories, corporate gifts, kitchen accessories, lifestyle products, wooden furniture, toys, dolls, educational equipment, etc. Channapatna Crafts Park is a registered society with representation from the Department of Industries & Commerce, Government of Karnataka. During the visit students gained practical knowledge about the handling of the raw materials, manufacturing process, coloring of toys etc. Mr.Lakshman, Operations Head, Shilpa Trust explained very effectively the processes involved in manufacturing wooden toys and accessories.






VISIT TO "SILK INDIA -2018"
