Once you have designed your clothing the sketches will need to be turned into technical drawing before patterns are to be created. For many aspiring designers who have shown the interest to learn flat pattern technique. Ms Renjani, Asst.Prof, National Institute of Fashion Technology was invited to conduct a workshop on "Flat Pattern Design". She thought the students how to obtain new designs by simply repositioning the darts or by altering them into various forms. She also highlighted on method of flat pattern techniques. VISIT TO WEAVERS SERVICE CENTRE

A one-day visit to WEAVERS' SERVICE CENTRE, BANGALORE was organized on 20th August 2019. 52 students and 4 faculty members were part of this program. WSC visit enlightened the students about Weaving, dyeing and Printing. Mr. Mohan, Textile Technologist explained about various types of loom, the spinning and the weaving process. Skilled weavers supervised by qualified textile technologists were engaged in weaving fabric samples in new designs. Prototype looms and weaving equipment were available in the Section. The section undertook modifications of looms and innovation of new weaving techniques to increase the production and improve the quality of products. An innovation in weaving of Molakalmuru sarees was in process during the visit. Mr. Mohan also explained about the kondi technique of weaving Ilkal sarees, the traditional textiles of Karnataka and the weaving of khan at Gulledgud.

Mrs. Revathi, qualified technical personnel explained in detail the method of application of dyestuffs, temperatures to be maintained, the length of dyeing period and fastness properties of the dyes. A detailed demo of application of Vat dyes to cotton yarns was shown to students. She also highlighted on the ban of azoic dyes, which are carcinogenic.

Students visited Printing section equipped with Block Printing, and screen printing facilities. They interacted with experts & skilled block printers and screen printers who were engaged in creating exclusive and unique printed samples using different printing techniques.

INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE

VET First Grade College organized a one-day conference on "Multidisciplinary research on challenges to change and development" on 19th Feb 2020. Around 500 participants attended the conference. The keynote speaker for the conference was Sreema. N. Setty, Transformation leader, Director, Metro AG Germany. Prof. Suresh Raghavendra, visiting professor of IIM, Bangalore and Mr. Thomas Henderson, Mind Specialist from International Mind Education Institute, South Korea, currently associated with IMEI as Karnataka State Director, were the plenary session speakers. We received around 334 research papers. We released three books; Conference Souvenir, ISBN Book and UGC Care listed Journal- Our Heritage.


