### Communication

### Interaction

- ➤ The College has developed a complaints policy to ensure that all concerns are dealt with by the College in the appropriate manner.
- ➤ Should a parent or guardian be unable to resolve an issue informally, they may lodge a complaint with the College.

### BREACH OF CODE OF CONDUCT

The consequences for breaching this Code of Conduct will be determined by the Principal in consultation with the concerned teacher and Head of the Department. The College may take such other steps as it may in its reasonable discretion, determined appropriate, according to the nature of the breach.

#### PARENT RELATION CELL
