Criterion 7.2.1 – Best Practices

Year 2021-2022

1. Title “Prakashnam - Light of knowledge”

Objectives:

1. To develop a research culture among staff and students.
2. To inculcate the habit of writing among students and staff

Context: Since many students are first generation learners, it becomes mandatory to inculcate writing habits in students.

Practice: e-newsletters Comtech, Faccio news and Wrapup VET Disha & Hand book like Anubandha, Parichay, committee book and Prospectus, Mitra, HR Policies Anveshane, are published

Problems encountered are rectification of grammatical errors and motivating the students to write articles.

Evidence of success: Publication of Wall magazine, Notice board magazine, e-newsletter, annual magazine, souvenir, ISBN books and various hand books to stake holders.

2. Title “Help Us To Help Others – Student’s Financial Aid”

Objectives:

1. To support the students in paying admission and examination
2. To ensure minimum dropout of students.
3. To help the economically weaker section

Context: The College has open door policy in admissions as per the vision and mission of the trust. It caters to financially and economically weaker sections of the society

It has been initiated in 2016-17 by the faculty giving a ray of hope to ensure continuity of students’ education.

Practice: Initially the contributors were one or two – either the Principal or few interested faculty members.

Problems encountered are Fixing of amount to be distributed and identifying the eligible students. Collection of fund is difficult as the contribution is totally voluntary.

Evidence of success:

2021-22 witnessed a collection of Rs. 40,750 which was utilized to support 28 students

3. Title “Clubs– way of learning”

Objectives: The objectives of the initiative are

1. To develop participative culture among students.
2. To inculcate the habit of learning through activities among students.

Context: Since College follows the open door policy during the admission. At time only interest of the students and parents background are verified for the admission. Students by fulfilling the requirement of university are admitted, they are monitored with mentoring, orientation, bridge course and remedial classed to clear the university examinations. The enrollment in clubs will help them learning through various platform like Spot light, vanijaya dhara, vanijaya Milana, Faccio, Chithara, Kreedha Saurabha, Shanthi dhama irrespective of the programme they opted.

Practice: initially students were given a choice to participate in the above mentioned clubs. Various academic and non-academic activities organized in these clubs encourages to volunteer themselves. Now these events are mean made benchmarks to award internal marks at university level.

Problems encountered and resources required:

Only few students used to attend the programme due to inferiority complex, as stated many students are the first generation learners. These clubs were quite new to them also few of stage making them to stay back.

Evidence of success: Students are capable of organizing the club events themselves. Annual inter collegiate cricket tournament, adoption of village, polio camp, fashion show, conferences, seminars, workshops are evidence of the success of the clubs.
