An online Guest lecture was organized on Psychology of Students towards academic satisfaction for all students on 28/01/22 by Dr Vani Shreedhar

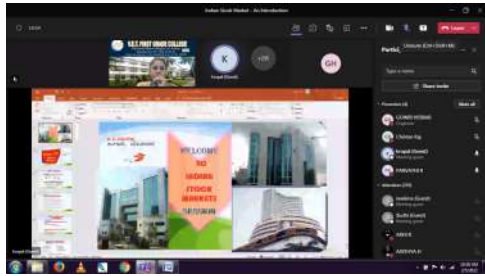
### Employability skills for the 21st century

To keep in touch with Parents and to pass on academic Information of students College conducted Parent Teachers meeting.

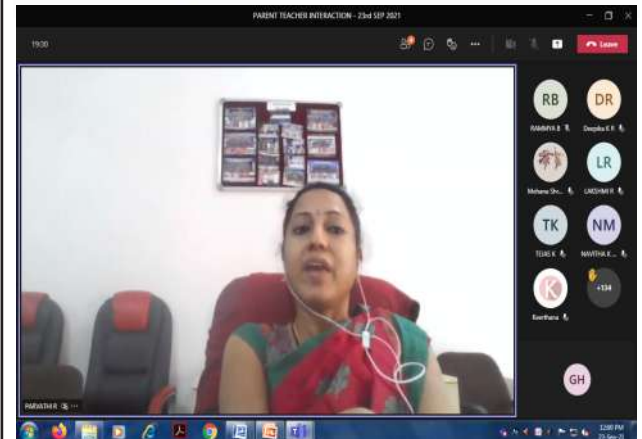
