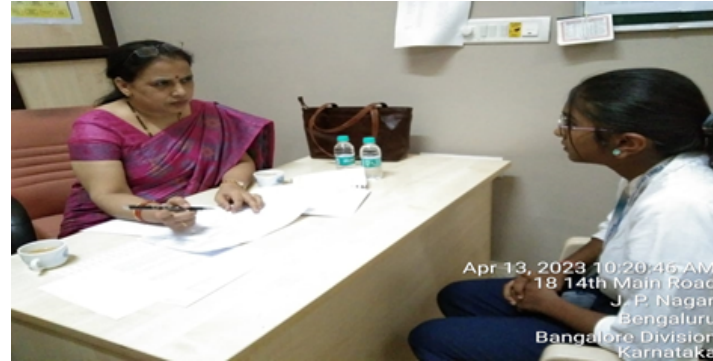
ORIENTATION SESSION:

2 Debate on GST: It is a group activity with two students in each group, Participants should speak either for or against GST

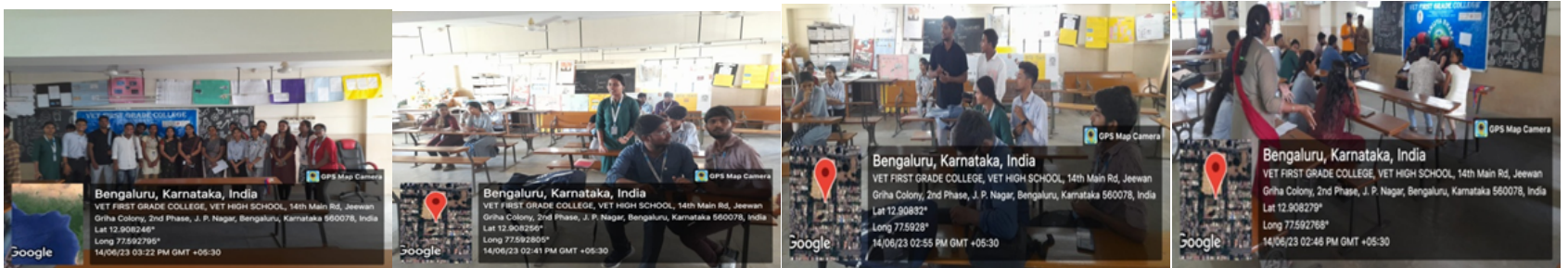
3 Roleplay: It is also an individual activity where students should perform as a sales manager and promote products and convince the customer to buy the product

3. Inculcate knowledge and the need based work skills.



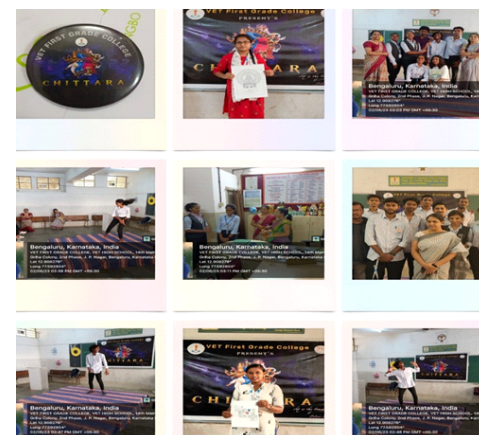
Students will participate individually and in groups according to the rules of events. Best participants are awarded medals and certificates. Students entry and exits are entered in login and logout book.
