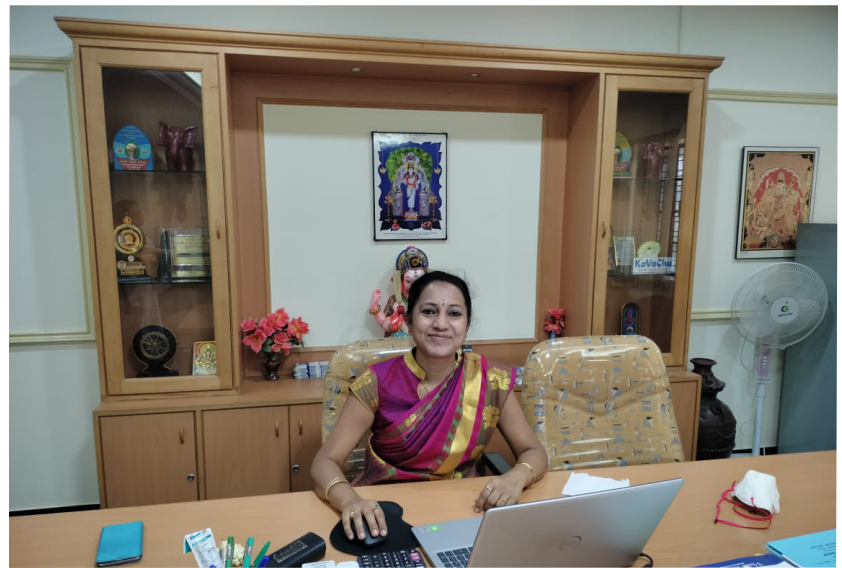

## Orientation Program for Associate Quality Professional Training Program

RSJ Inspection Service Limited which is a recipient of GOLD+ recognition in CII EXIM Bank Award program 2020 conducted an orientation session for FAD students on Associate Quality Professional- Training Program.

RSJ is one of the leading companies in third party inspection. It is providing quality control inspection, lab testing management and factory audits for customers from across the world (USA, UK, GERMANY, FRANCE, INDIA, HONKONG, CHINA, AUSTRALIA, etc). This program was organised for final year and second year students. The Associate Quality professional training Program enables the graduates to find the best possible places in industry, enhance their communication and problem solving skills. Students will be trained with programs such as certified quality professional, certified auditor ISO 9001-2015, SA8000, ISO 17020.

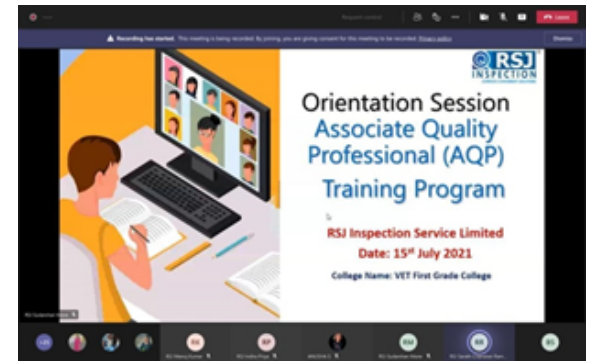
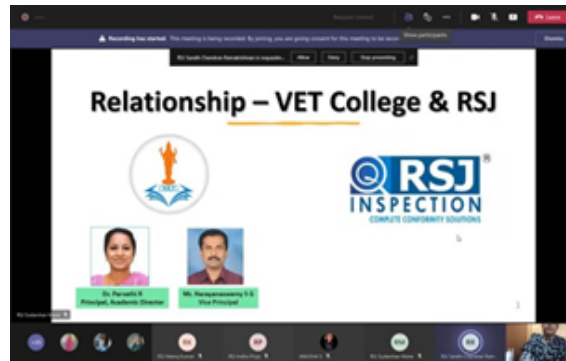
The program is divided into three levels. Level 1- General Awareness - Quality/Management System which is a period of 8 weeks (50-60 hrs).

Level 2- Quality Auditor-General for a period of 8-1 weeks (80-100 hrs).

Level 3- Quality Engineer- Training (Textiles & Apparels) for a period of 8-12 weeks (600hrs).

A candidate who successfully completes Level- 3 of this program will be considered for fulltime job in RSJ Inspection Service Limited. Initially the job offer will be as Quality Engineer and in later years, candidates may be moved into other departments like audit or assessment, client service etc. based on the company need and requirements.

This orientation was organised mainly to shortlist the candidates for AQP Training Program. Shortlisted students will be interviewed and accordingly selected for the program. A total of 40 students attended the orientation. Mr. Sarath Chandran, Executive Director, RSJ Inspection Service Limited gave a detailed insight of the program along with his team which comprised of Mr. Sudarshan Mane, Regional Manager, South, Mr. Manoj Kumar and Miss Indira Priya training Professionals. The session went on for an hour on 15th July 2021 from 4.00-5.00 pm in Microsoft teams. The interested students were asked to fill the forms through the link forwarded to them. Once application received, groups will be created on "Line App". The course is tentatively scheduled from second week of August and is free of cost; however students wanting certifications shall be registered and offered a certificate on successful completion of the course.
