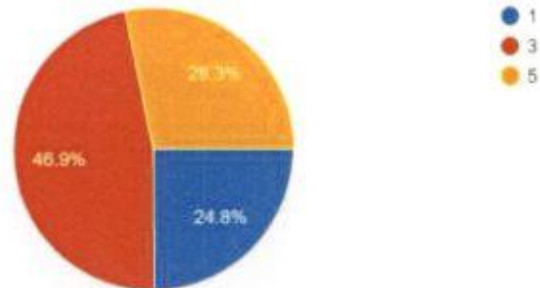

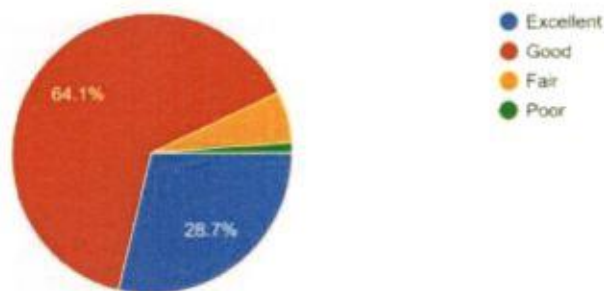

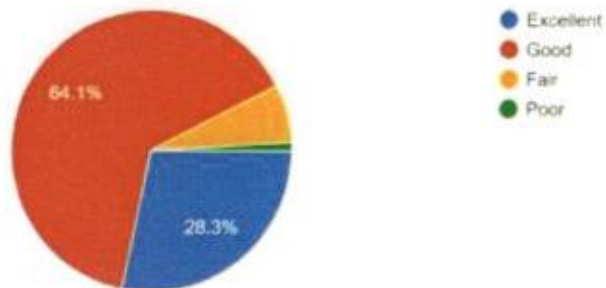

2. DEPTH OF TOPICS COVERED IN THE SYLLABUS

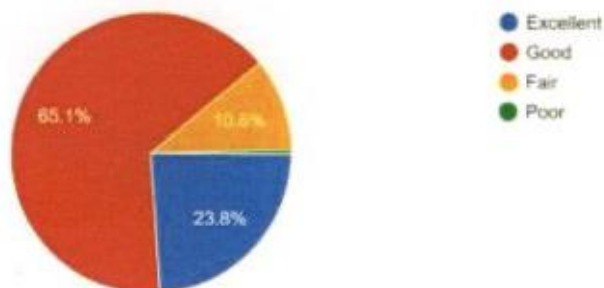

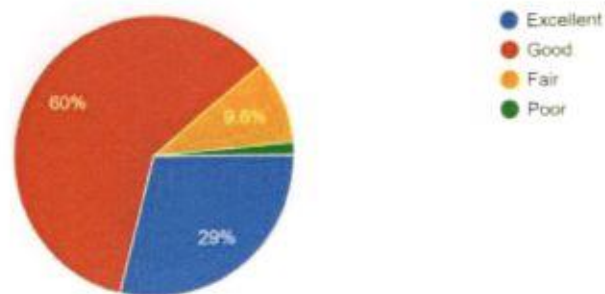

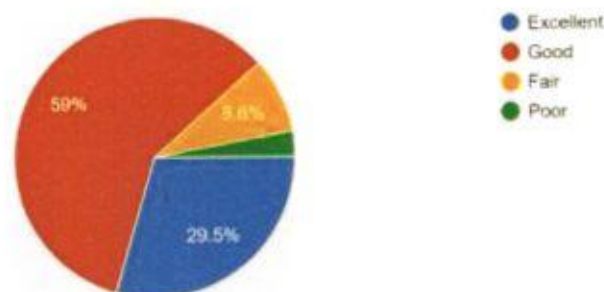
407 responses

5. RELEVANCE OF TEXTBOOKS AND REFERENCE BOOKS WITH THE CURRICULUM

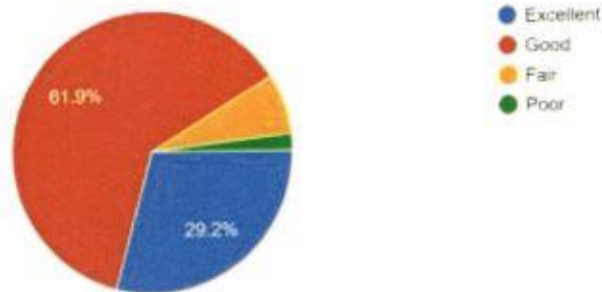
407 responses

6. INCLUSION OF VALUE BASED EDUCATION IN THE SYLLABUS

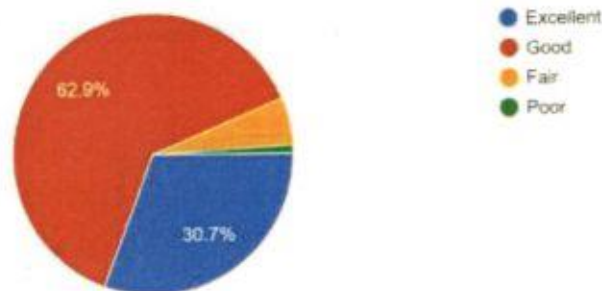



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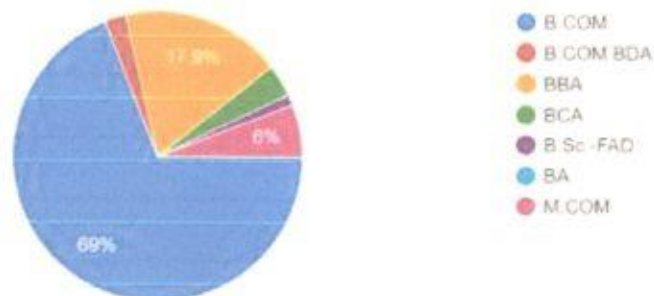

84 responses

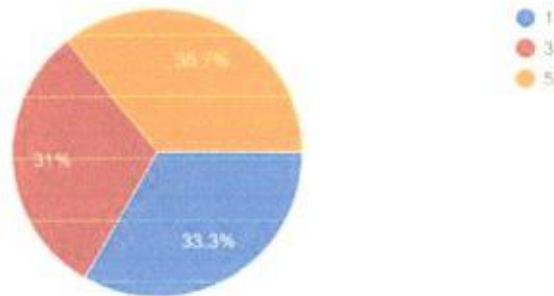


The results of the parent feedback for the academic year 2022-2023 is as under.

SEMESTER

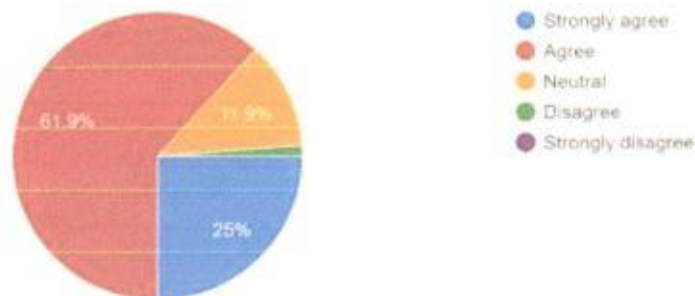

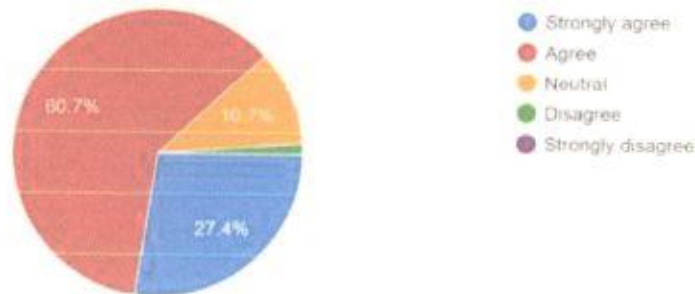

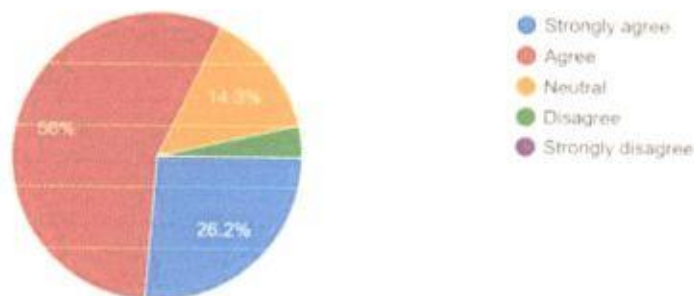

3. EMPLOYABILITY IS GIVEN IMPORTANCE IN THE COLLEGE

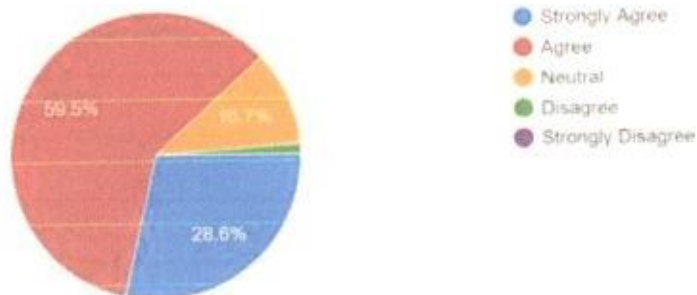
84 responses

5. IMPORTANCE IS GIVEN TO NSS, SPORTS & CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

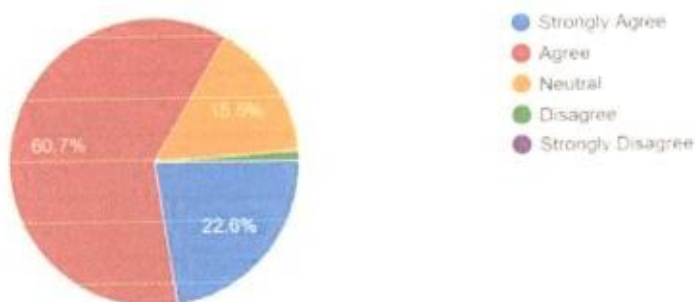
84 responses

6. COLLEGE INFRASTRUCTURE IS WELL MAINTAINED

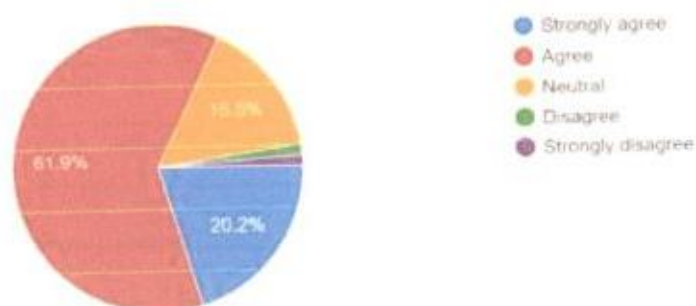
84 responses

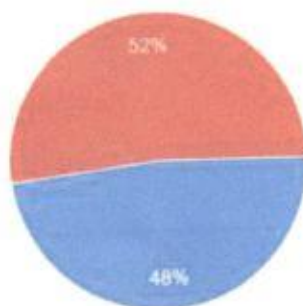

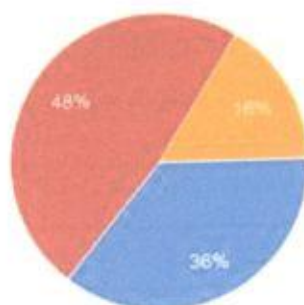

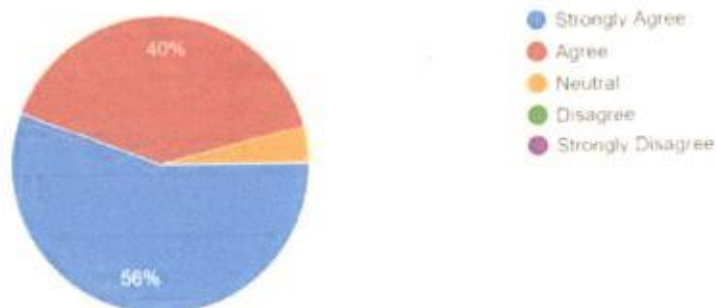

5. Academically weak Students are encouraged with Remedial Classes

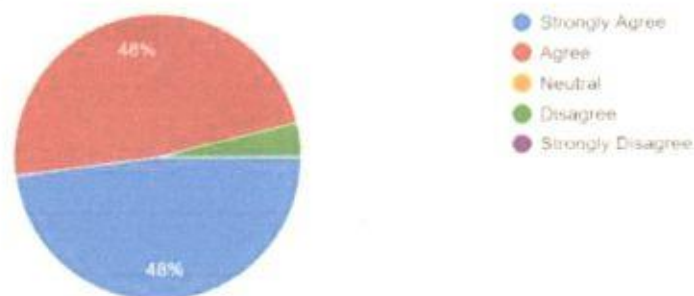

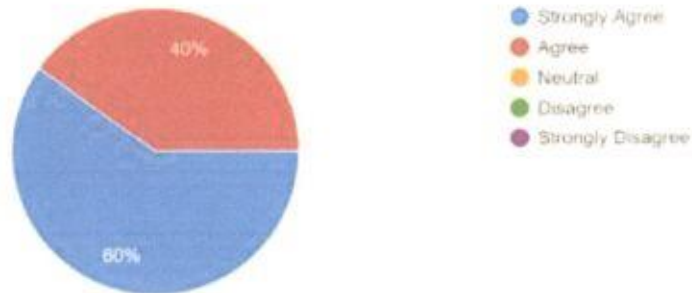

7. Library is given Preference

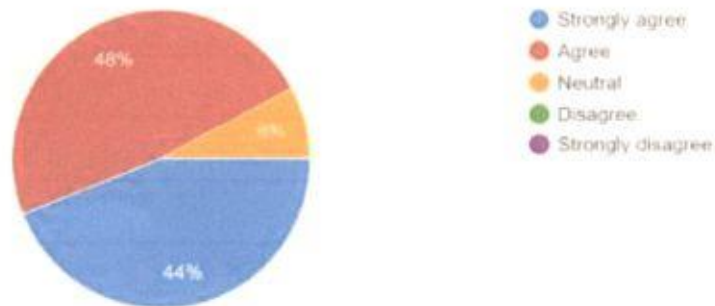

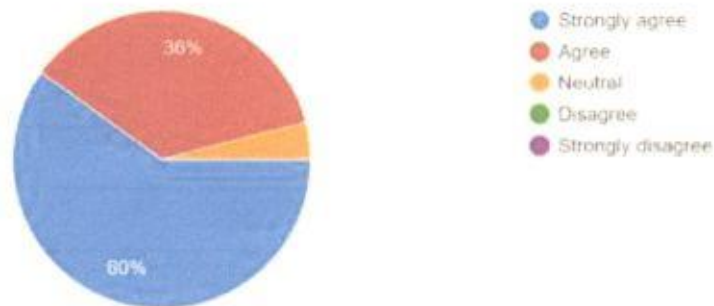

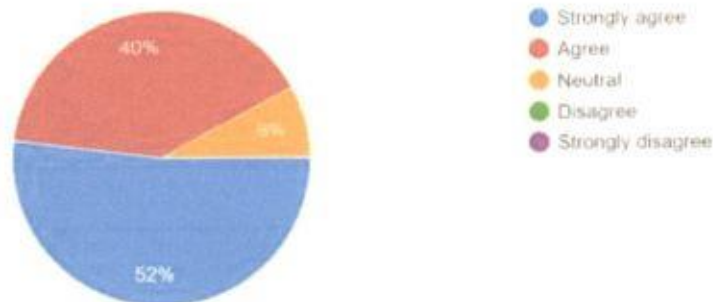


Professors are encouraged to plan and take part in academic events including seminars, workshops, symposiums, and conferences, according to 96% of respondents; the remaining 4%

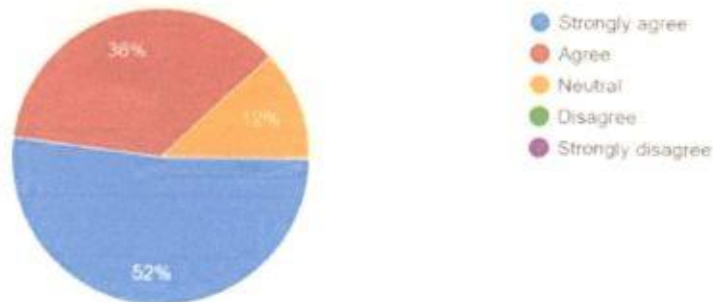

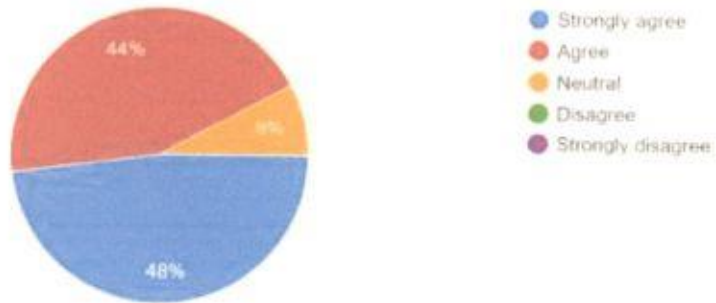


88% of them strongly concur that there are sufficient professors and facilities for a learning environment, including classrooms, amenities, and others, while the remaining 12% are unsure.

15. The Laboratories are well equipped

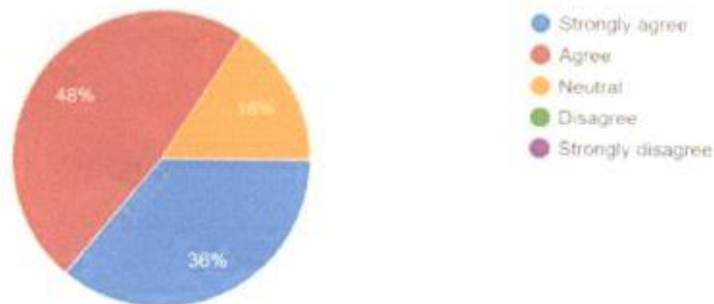

16. The Administration is readily accessible

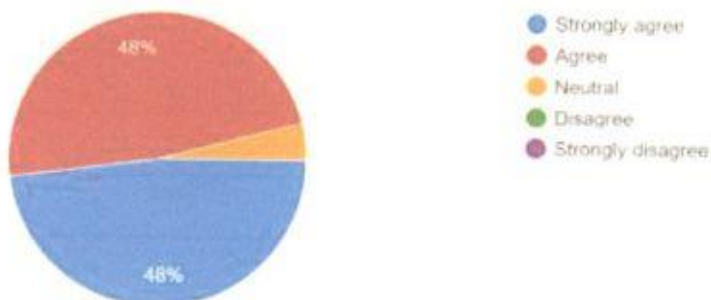

17. The Quality initiatives are taken up to match above the Curriculum

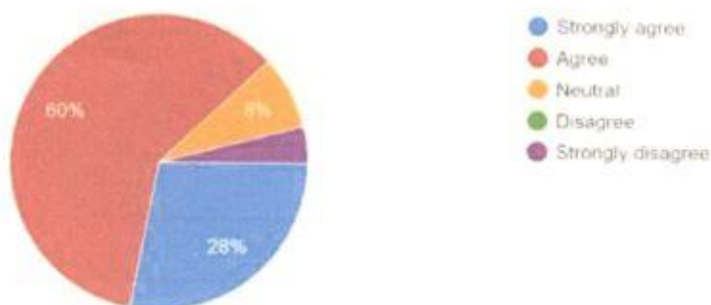

18. The Faculty members are given freedom to express their opinion

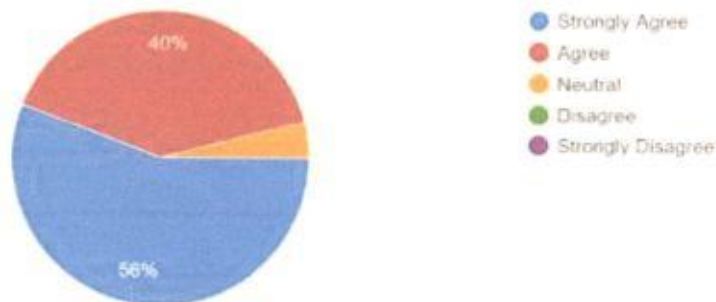
25 responses

19. The IQAC functions regularly to promote the quality of the Institution

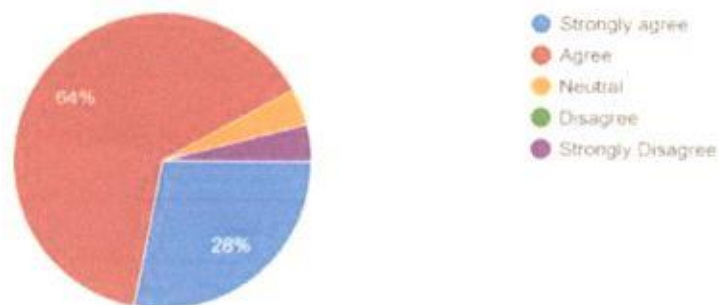



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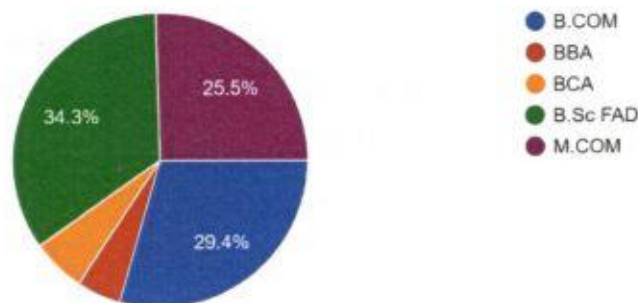

DEGREE YOU COMPLETED AT VET FGC

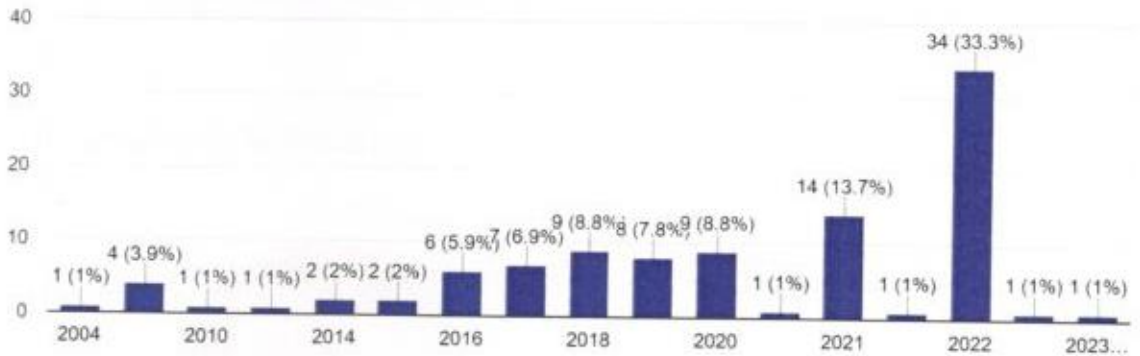

YEAR OF PASSING

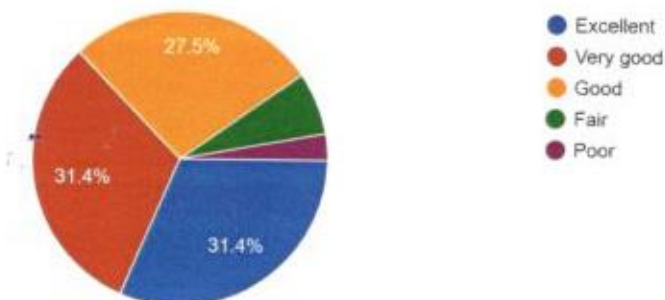

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

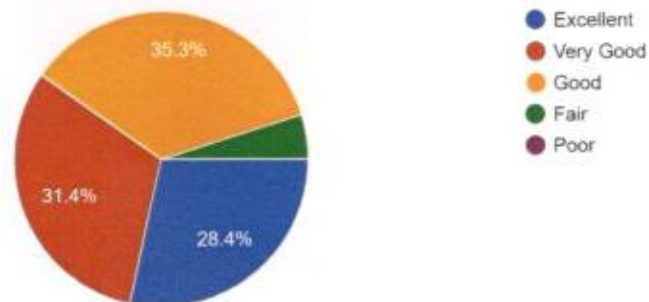

FEES STRUCTURE AND ENVIRONMENT

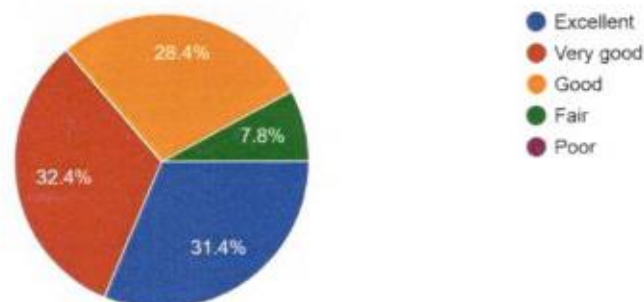

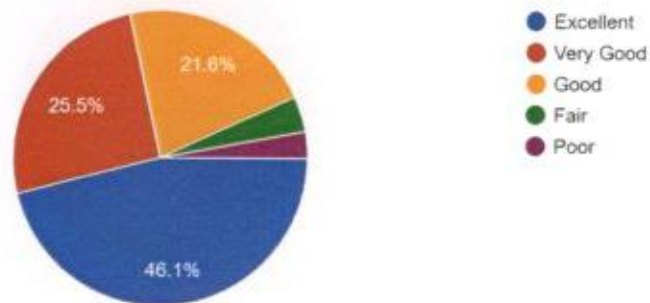

FACULTY AND TEACHING METHODOLOGY

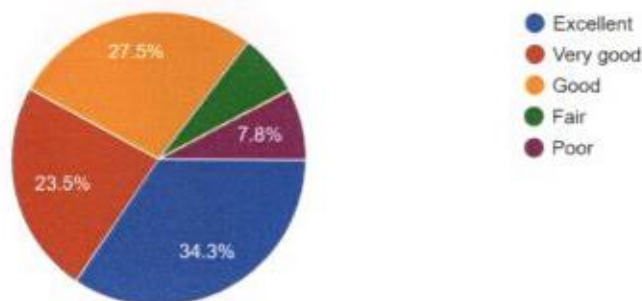

PROJECT GUIDANCE AND INDUSTRIAL VISIT

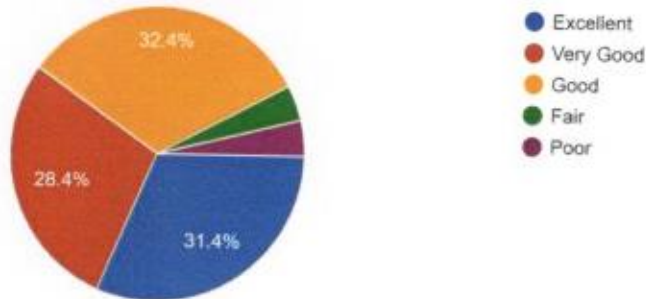

QUALITY OF SUPPORT MATERIAL, WORKSHOP AND SEMINAR

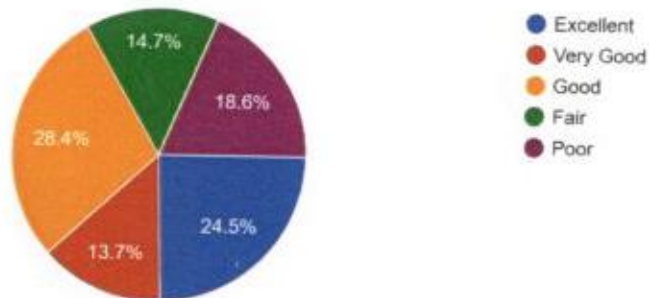

TRAINING, PLACEMENTS AND CAREER GUIDANCE

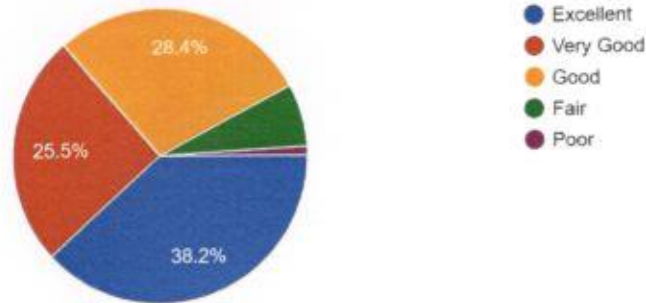

LIBRARY AND E-BOOKS

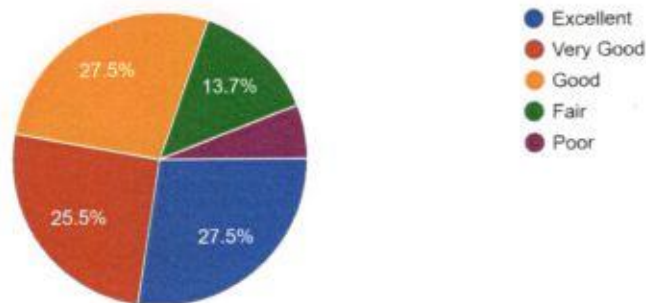

CURRICULUM IS RELEVANT TO CORPORATE

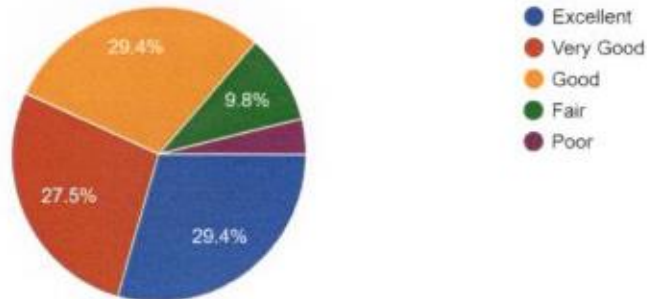

ADDITIONAL SKILLS

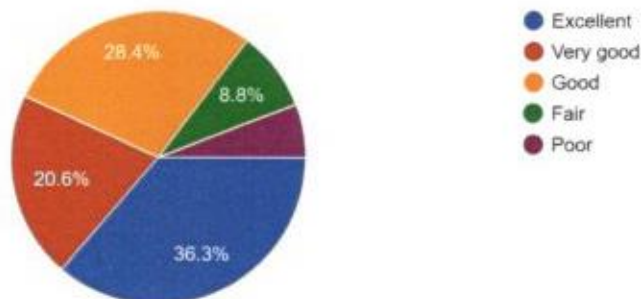

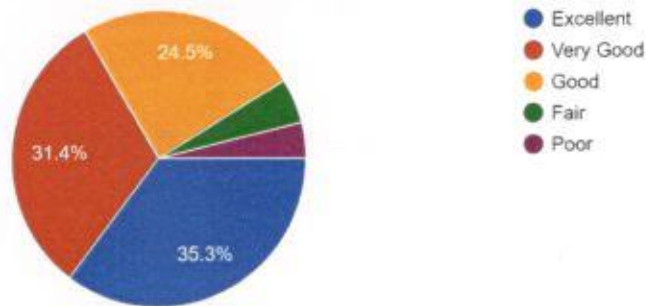
ALUMNI ASSOCIATION / NETWORK OF OLD FRIENDS
