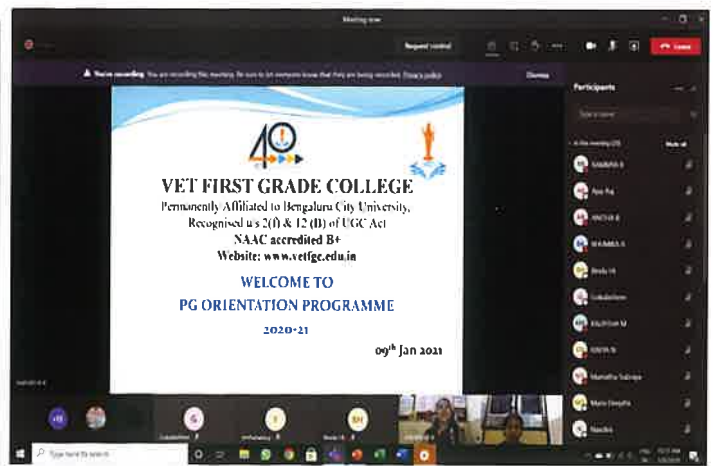
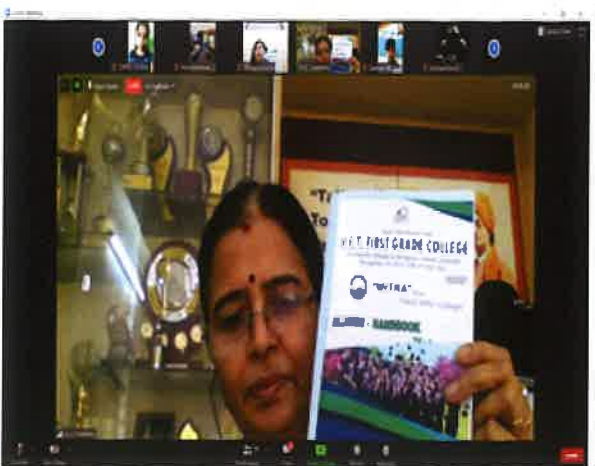
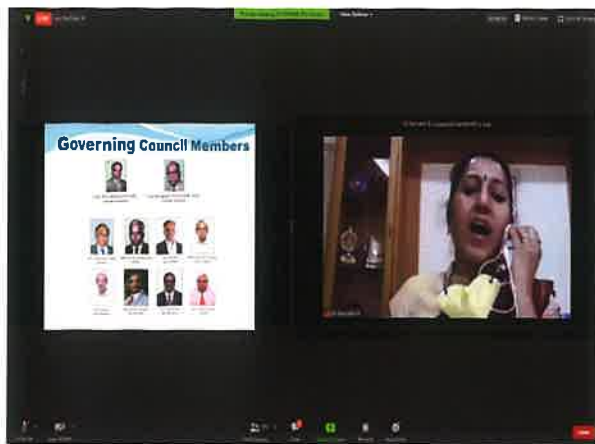


VET First Grade College organised Two Day International Webinar on “New Normal for Gen Z” in association with Rotary Bengaluru Spandana. This International webinar was held on 9th & 10th June 2020 using virtual platform. In the crucial time of COVID-19 pandemic the entire world is looking for new pathways for survival. The webinar witnessed 5 speakers over 2 days – Mr. Sameer Hariani, Dentist by profession and a trainer on online lifestyle speaking on the topic - Dazzle your way to online teaching, Mr. Choi, Hyeonyong, Chairman of International Youth Fellowship, Sri Lanka and Director of International Mind Education Institute, Sri Lanka spoke on topic Finding hope and courage, Mr. Thomas Henderson, Director of International Mind Education Institute for Karnataka State, India who spoke on topic Power of Connection, Dr. Shyam Lal Soni, Director of National Institute of Technology, Uttarakhand spoke on topic Tri-generation and Prof. Sandya R., Visiting faculty at Manipal University, Department of Commerce spoke on the topic- “Re-alignment of Social Science research to address contemporary issue”. The webinar was attended by over 200 participants – faculty and students and was extremely helpful for all the participants.



## Orientation Virtual – 14th September 2020 (UG) and 9th January 2021(PG)

The first ever virtual orientation programme 2020 to welcome the new incumbents to the college was conducted on 14th September 2020 for under graduation and on 9th January 2021 for M.Com through virtual platform via Zoom and Microsoft teams respectively. Dr Parvathi oriented the students about Objectives, Mission and Vision of the college, the founding trustees, the current management team, teaching and non-teaching fraternity, details about courses, short term courses, the various committees that are functioning in the college, the various curricular and co-curricular activities at the college, the examination pattern and allotment of marks and all other relevant details necessary to the students. The Principal gave complete details from entering the college till Graduation after 3 years. This was followed by virtual and symbolic release of Handbooks namely – Parichay – a student handbook, Anubandha – Parent handbook about the code of conduct, Anveshane-IQAC handbook for quality enhancement in college, Committee handbook detailing about committees and Mitra – Alumni handbook emphasizing the linkage of students with alma mater by the dignitaries.





## VACCINATION DRIVE – Prevention against pandemic

The coronavirus pandemic has taken the whole world by storm. While people are caught up in the fear of contracting the virus and same has led to severe disruptions and widespread confusion among people. The teaching and learning in India and across the world also changed rapidly over the course of the crisis.

With more cases being reported from schools and colleges, focus was on vaccinating as many staff as possible. In view of this backdrop, Dr.R.Parvathi, principal & academic director, of VET FGC COLLEGE, planned and organised a camp in the campus on 17th April 2021 in association with BBMP and Primary Health Centre, J P Nagar, Bangalore for faculty and family members in the category of 45 years and above. In total, 45 members got vaccinated. In addition to this, regular periodic testing camps were organised to ensure learning is not disrupted and to protect the safety of faculty and students at large.



## Energy Audit – 16th April 2021

The Energy audit for the first time was organised by IQAC for VET First Grade College and other sister institutions at J P Nagar on 16th April 2021.

Energy audit is the audit of energy consumption and conservation at the Institution, and it reflects on the usage of the energy in the institution. This is one of the requirements under Criteria 7 in NAAC and inculcates the habit of conservation of energy by the institutions. The audit was an IQAC initiative arranged in association with MGIRED – Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Rural Energy and Development, based in Jakkur. Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Rural Energy and Development (MGIRED) that is in Bengaluru, was established in the year 2000 with assistance of Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE), Government of India and the Rural Development & Panchayat Raj Dept., Government of Karnataka. The main objective was to have a unique Institution to carry out Capacity Building and Awareness Programmes in the areas of Rural Energy and Sustainable Rural Development that will cater to the needs of Karnataka and neighboring southern states namely Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Tamil Nadu, Kerala, and Union Territory Pondicherry. It is one of its main initiatives include Conducting "Walk-through" Energy assessment of institutions to facilitate energy conservation through awareness creation and minimal investment recommendations (source: <https://mgired.kar.nic.in/about-us.html>). It was a free Energy Audit by MGIRED.



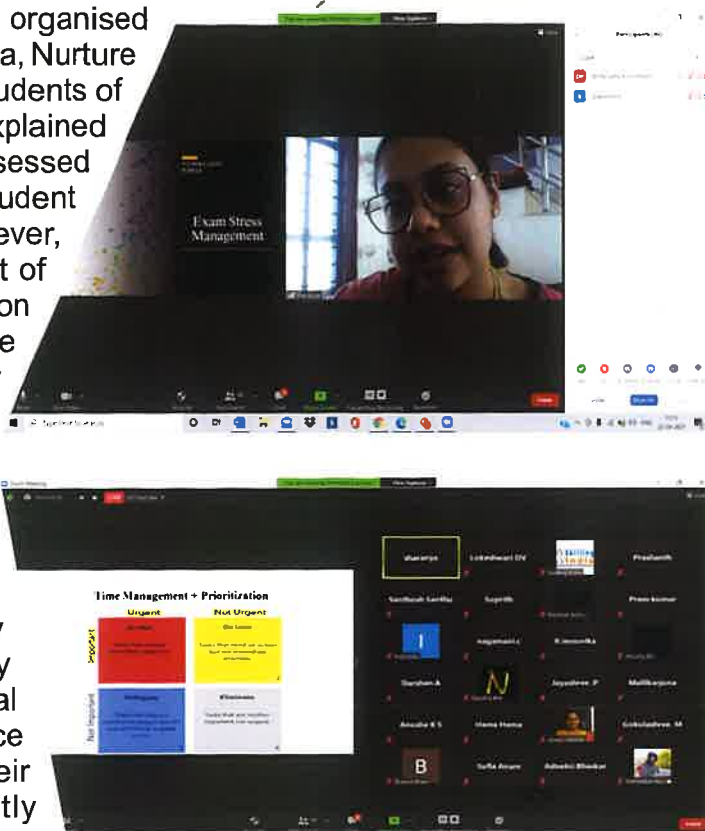
On 16th April 2021, 3 assessors from MGIRED headed by Mr. Pramod came to the institution at 10.30 am and started their walk-through energy assessment after having a brief meeting with Dr R Parvathi, Principal and Academic Director. They walked through the entire building of V.E.T First Grade college starting with the FGC Board room, Principal's Cabin, Office, Library, Lecture rooms, other facilities like sports room, women's room, health Centre, storerooms, toilets, and

terrace. They noted in detail the dimensions of the same, the number of bulbs, fans, projectors, and others that require and consume electrical power. They also checked the natural lighting of the rooms using an instrument. They pointed out that Lecture Hall 110 and 206 are ideally placed in terms of natural lighting. The entire Walk-through audit took a total of 3 hours to complete. It was a wonderful experience and helped the institution in understanding few aspects of Energy.

## IN-HOUSE SEMINARS & WORKSHOPS

### Webinar on Stress Management

Exam stress management workshop was organised on 2/6/2021 in association with skilling India, Nurture talent for beautiful future for all 1st year students of all the courses. The resource person explained about exam stress and how it can be assessed as exams are a way of assessing what a student has learnt during the academic year. However, for most students, exams bring with it lot of tension, stress and anxiety. The main reason for this is because of increased pressure and stress that they receive from their parents and teachers to perform well in the exams. Although a little bit of exam fear and anxiousness is important to study and learn before the exams, too much tension can hamper the student's ability to do well. Many times, due to exam fear, students tend to forget what they have learnt, thus scoring less than they could have. Hence, it is extremely crucial for students to learn about how to reduce exam fear, so that they can give their examination confidently, subsequently earning good grades.



### Post covid substance of environmental consciousness

COVID-19 was declared a “pandemic” by the World Health Organization (WHO) in early March 2020. Globally, extraordinary measures are being adopted to combat the formidable spread of the ongoing outbreak. Under such conditions, people's adherence to preventive measures is greatly affected by their awareness of the disease. This workshop organised on 05-06-2020 and the resource person stated that the spread of COVID-19 has been declared a public health pandemic that causes international concern, and the disease has now spread to many countries and regions. While there is still much that we do not know about the virus that causes COVID-19 disease, we know that COVID-19 spread through direct contact with the respiratory droplets of an infected person (which is caused by coughing or sneezing). Individuals can also become infected by coming into contact with contaminated surfaces of the virus and then touching their faces (eyes, nose, and mouth). As COVID-19 continues to spread, it is important to take action to prevent further infection, reduce the impact of the disease, and support procedures to control it.

#### What is a pandemic?

- A **pandemic** is an epidemic that has spread over a large region of the world.
- For example, the Spanish flu of 1918-1920 infected 500 million people (about 1/3 of the Earth's population at that time) and killed an estimated 50 million people.
- Before 2020, the most recent pandemic was the 2009 H1N1 swine flu. It infected about 10-20% of the world's population and killed 150,000-500,000 people.



Spanish flu pandemic 1918-1919





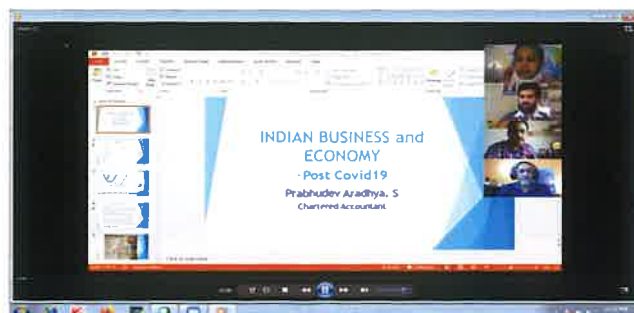
## Webinar on Visible Light Communication - Dr Parvathi Angadi

VET First Grade College organized one day webinar on -“Post COVID-19, Indian Business and Economy” In association with Rotary Bangalore Spandana on 8th June 2020 at 10.00 A.M., for M.Com, VI Sem B.Com & BBA students through Zoom Platform. We believe that W-shaped recovery is the most likely outcome for India, given the current state of dramatically increasing COVID-19 cases and the conservative economic stimulus measures. V-Shape Quick recovery, U-Shape Global slowdown shrinks of growth with slow return to trend growth, W-Shape multiple waves with multiple rebounds, preventing long-term economic stabilization, but allowing targeted recoveries and L-Shape Recession server decline without any return to growth for many years.



## International Yoga Day – “Yoga with Family”



Webinar on International Yoga Day – “Yoga with Family” in association with Nrithya Disha Trust, Swami Vivekananda Raja Yoga Kendra and Bharathiya Seva Samsthe was organised on 21/06/2020 at 8:25AM for all faculties and students. 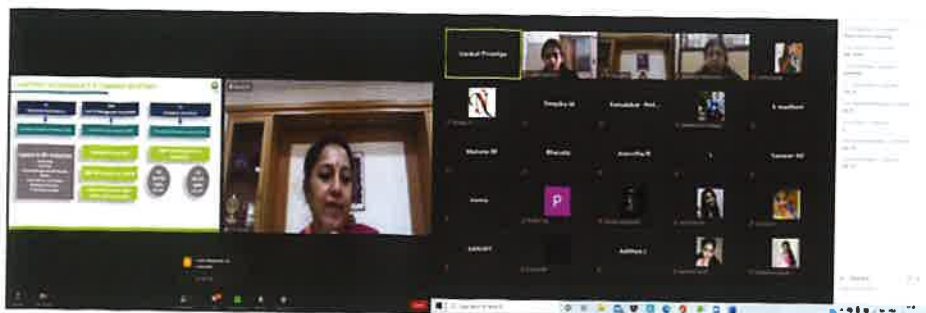
## DELNET Networked Resources & Services – Dr Sangeetha, Delnet

### **Current Digital Marketing trends in the industry - Mr. Rajeev S Venugopal**

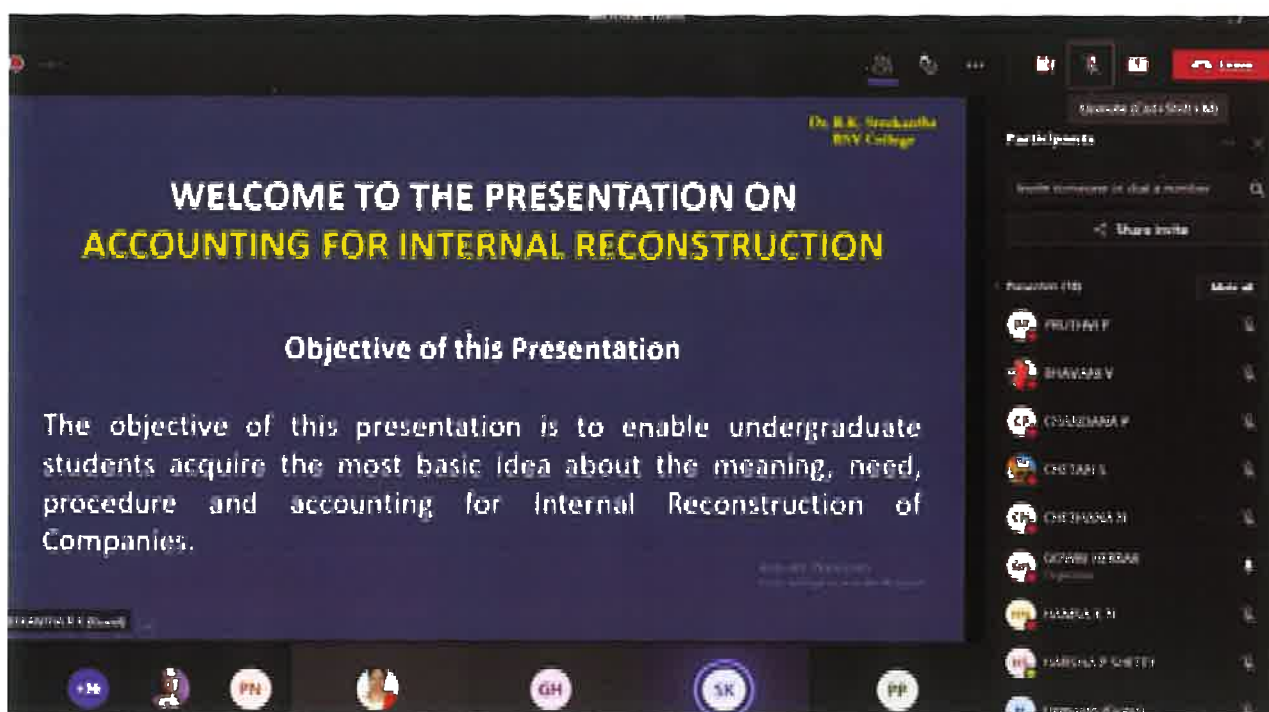

## Guest lecture on commercial arithmetic compound interest and its application

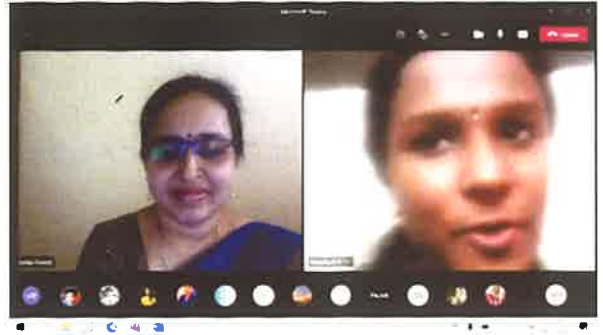

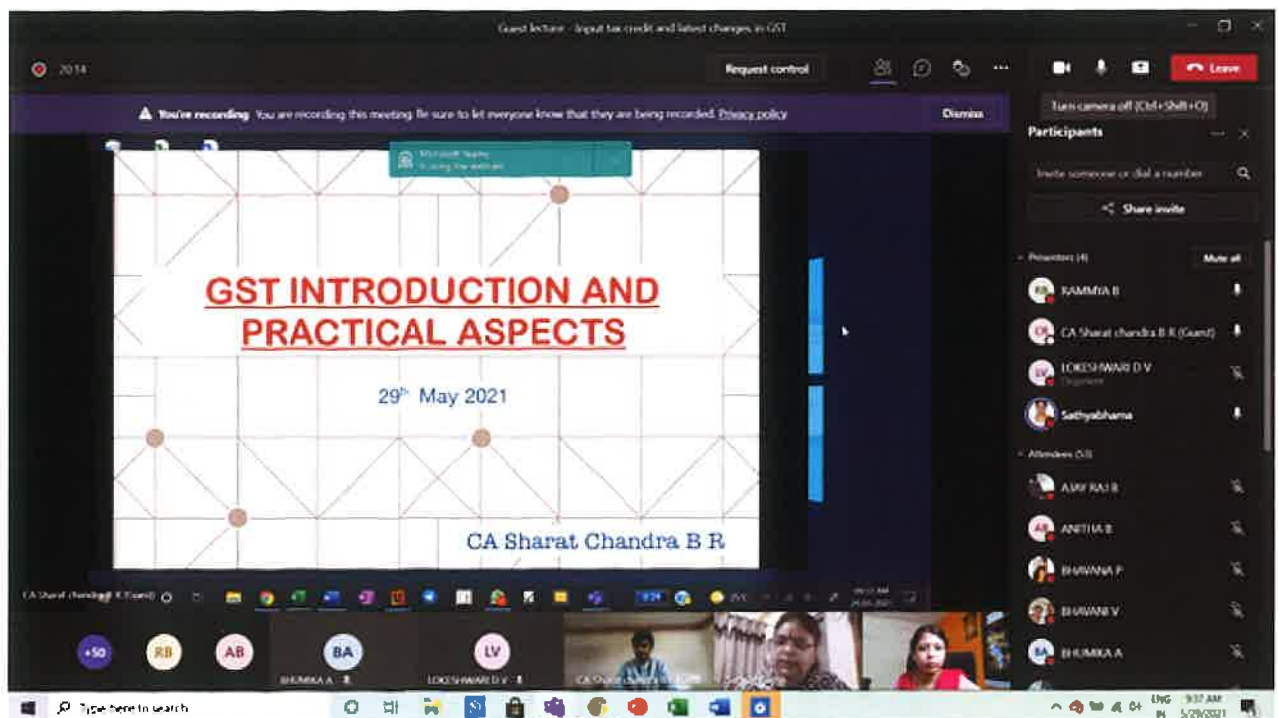


## Workshop on an introduction to artificial intelligence

## National Unity Day - 31/10/2020

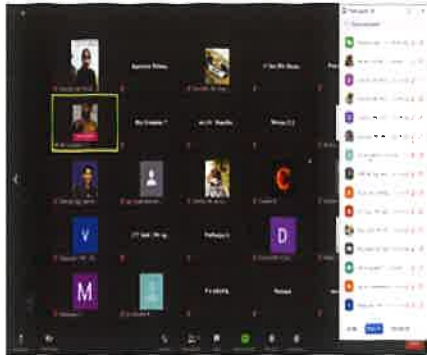

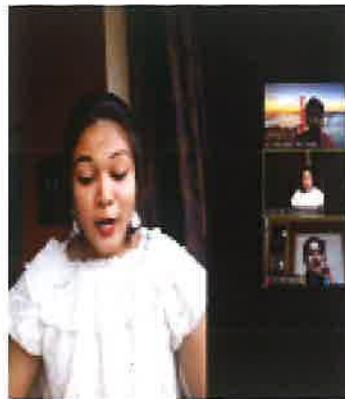
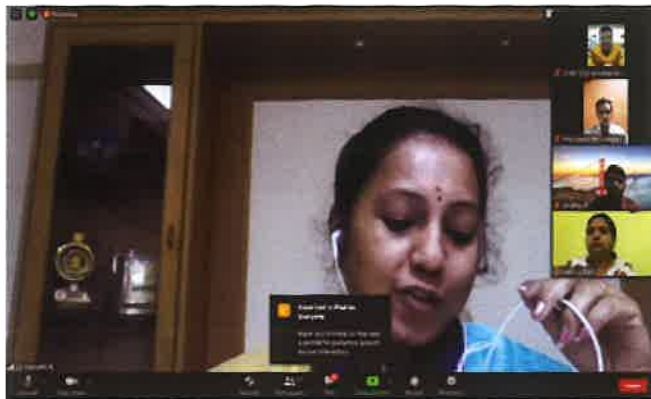
## Gandhi Jayanthi - 03/10/2020

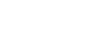

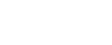
