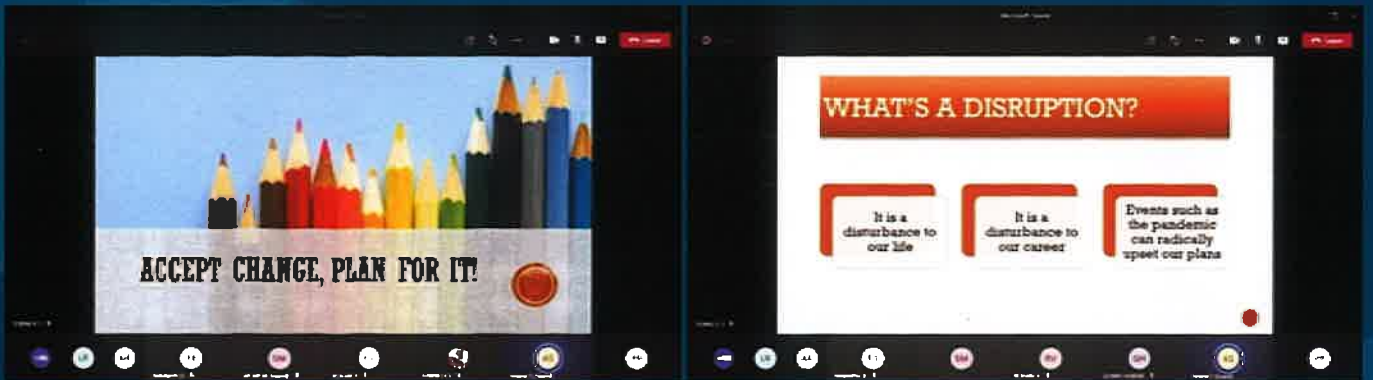
Webinar on Business plan for Start-ups

Orientation Workshop in association with skilling India

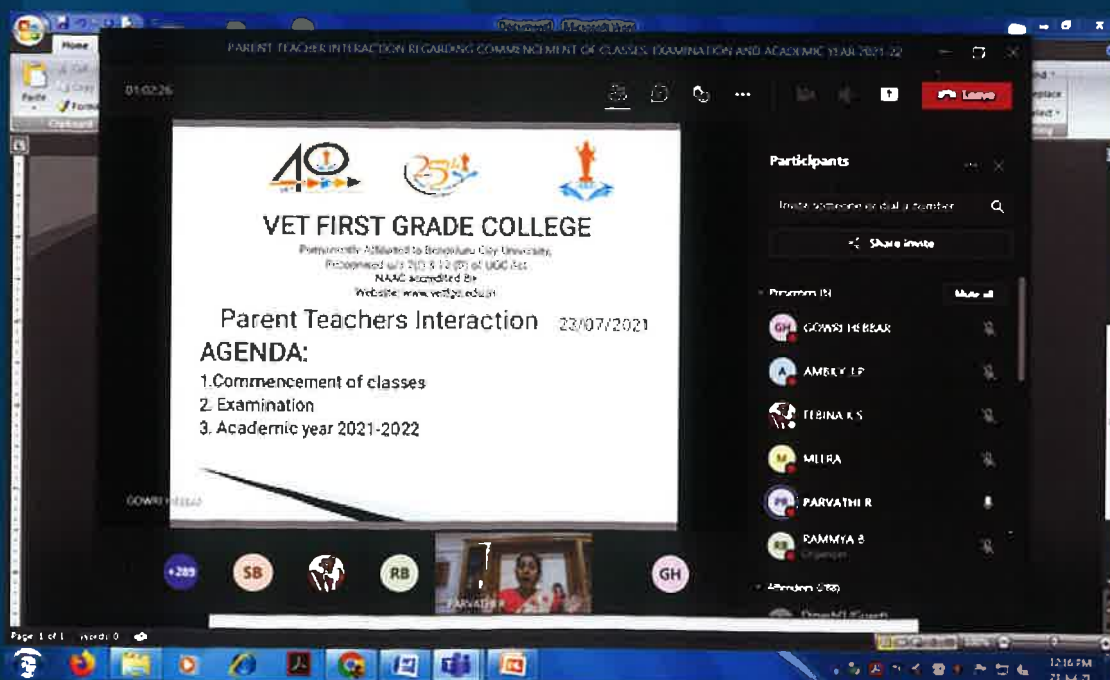

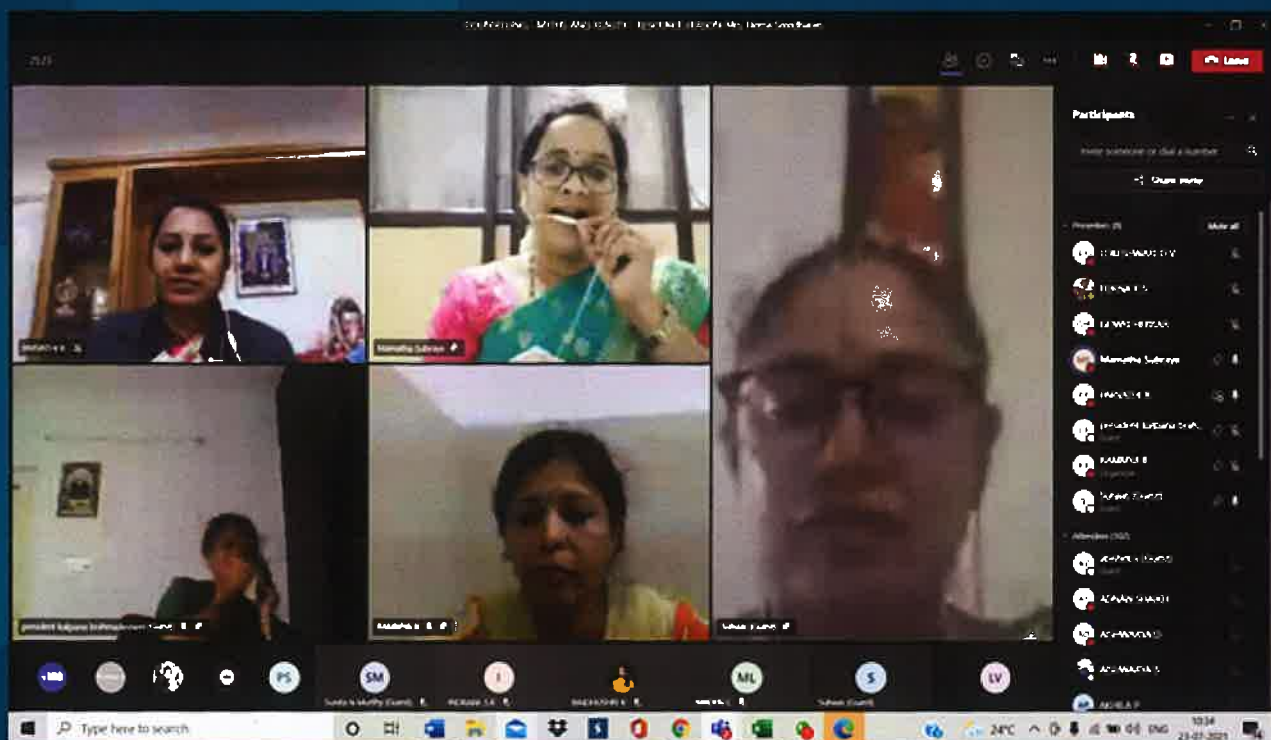


GST – Input Tax Credit

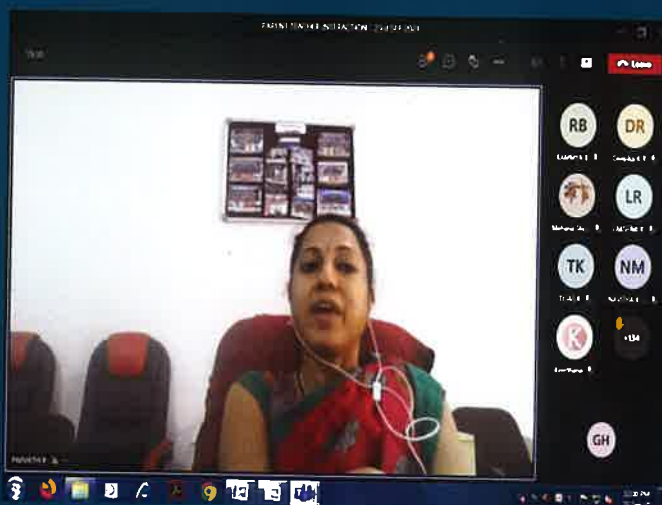

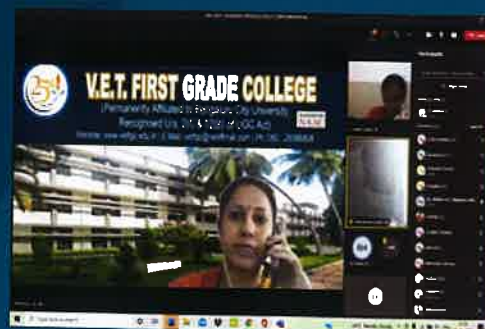
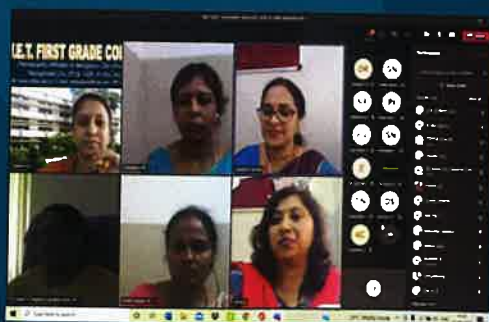
BBA SPECIALIZATION INTERACTION

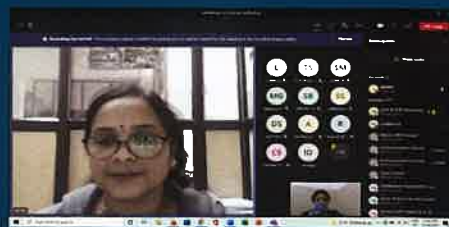
WORKSHOP ON HUMAN TRAFFICKING

Further explaining on healthy lifestyle, healthy routine, healthy behavior, healthy thought process, she quoted several real time examples and asked students to understand and compare their status.

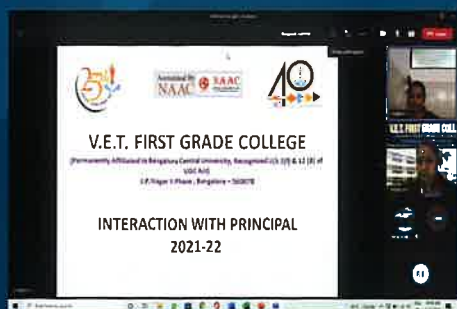
Through these sessions, the students were able to develop certain problem-solving skills which to an extent help them deal with particular issues surrounding their lives.

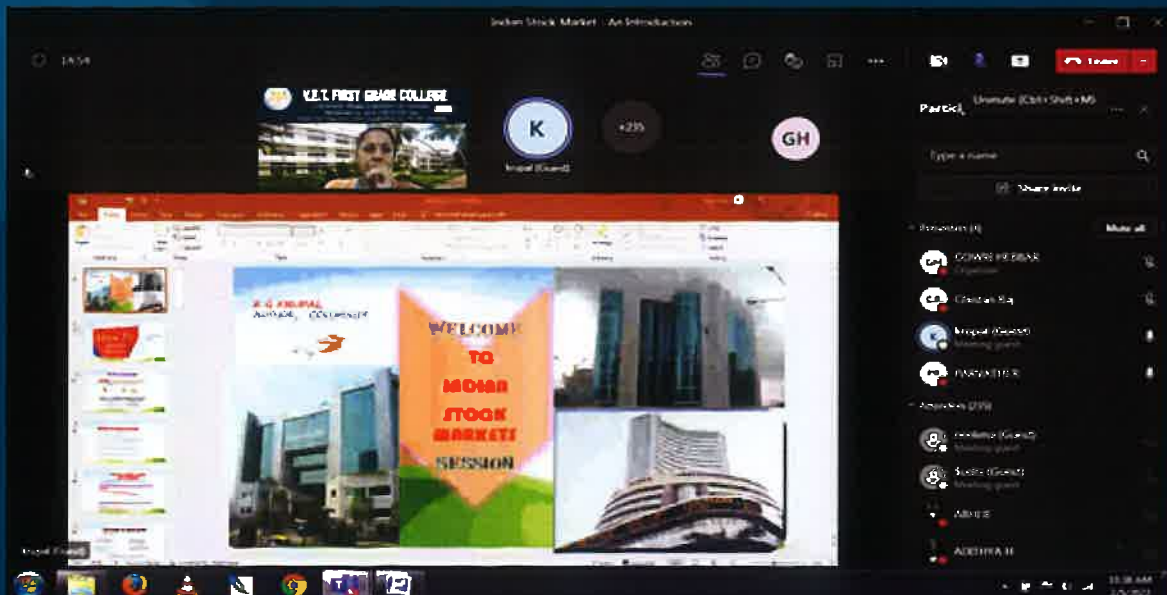

The session was to help students to get introduced to stock market and learn about trading and get awareness about shares, stocks, bonds and commodities.



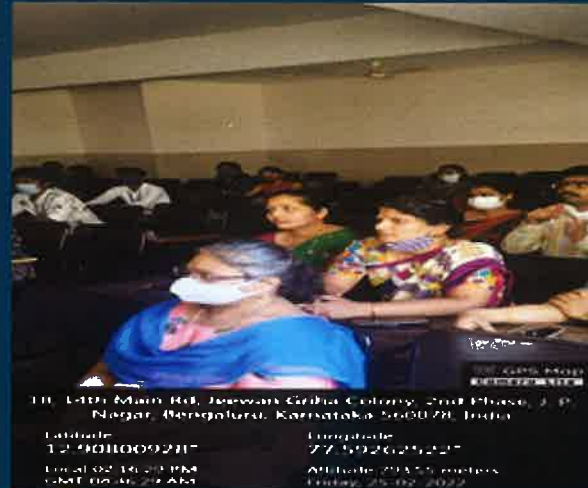
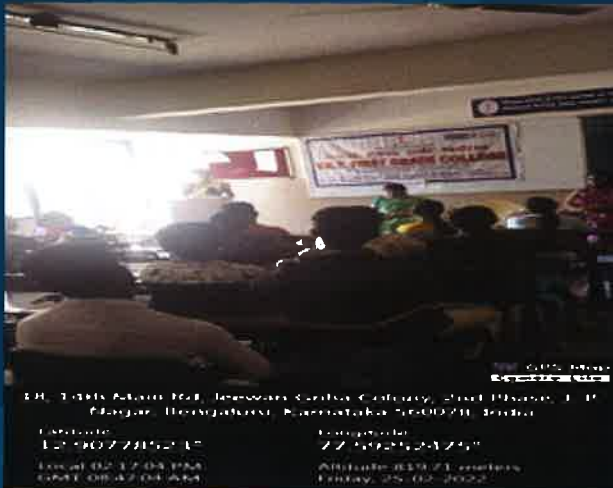
ERP – Next element for Faculty Members

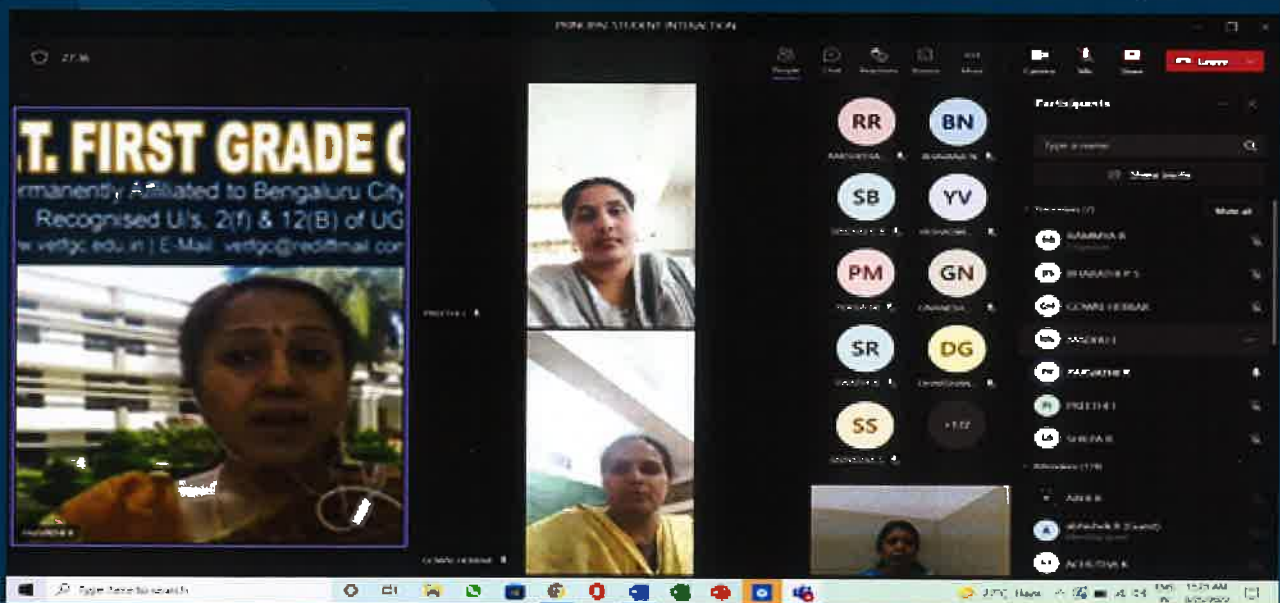

CAREER COGNIZANCE

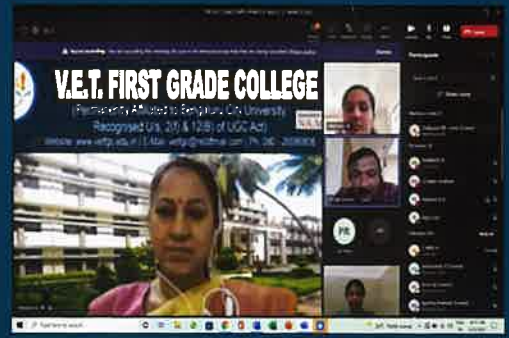

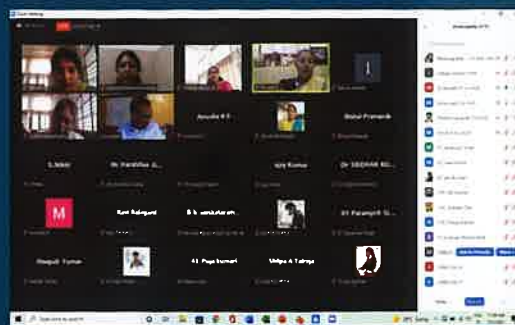
BASIC COMMUNICATION SKILLS – SHORT TERM COURSE

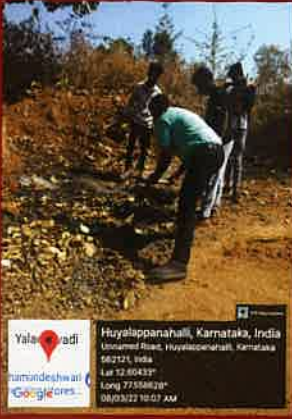
