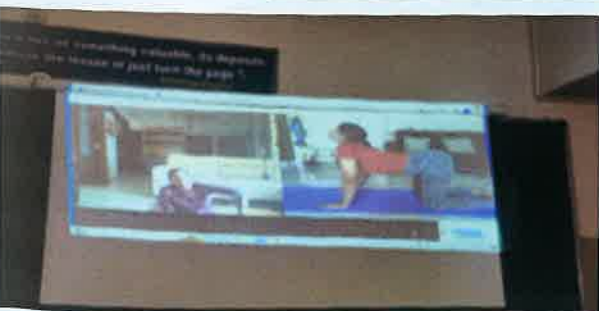

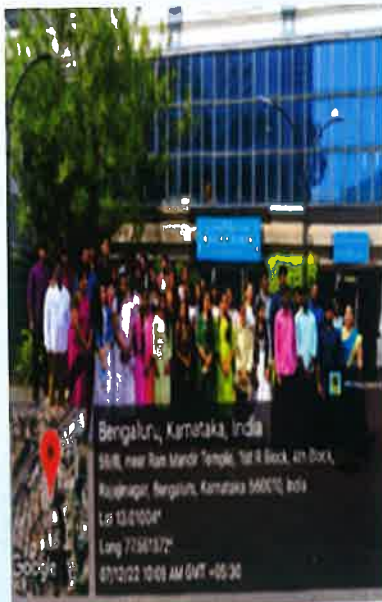
Workshop On Basic communication skills

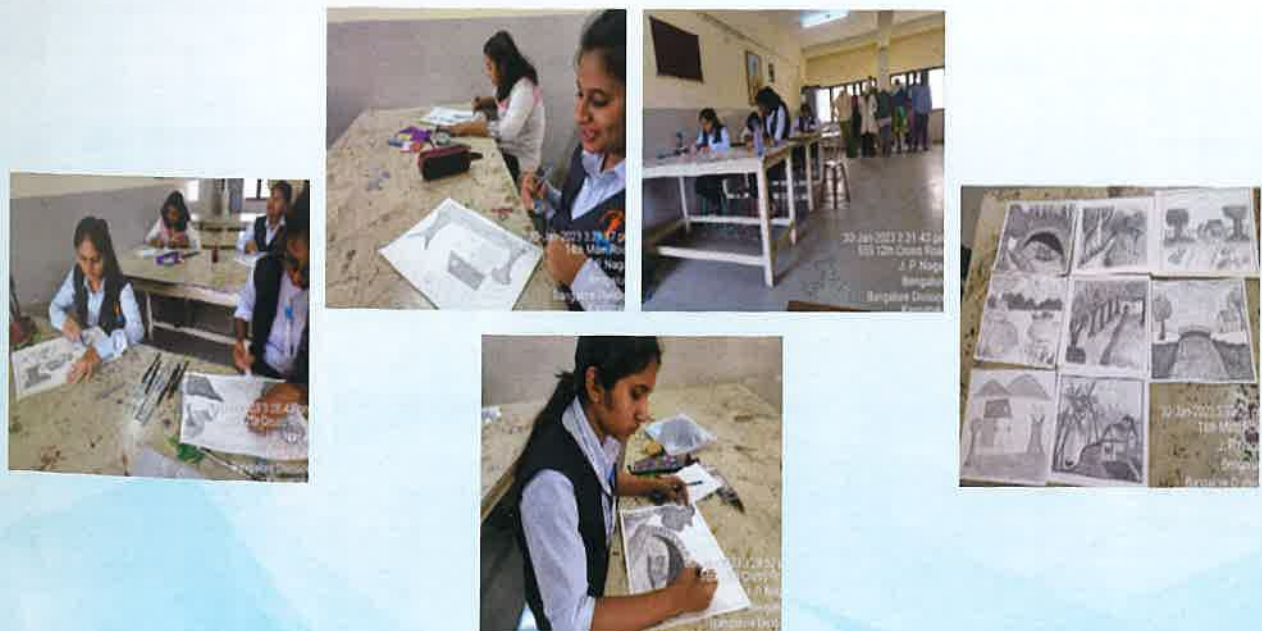


Pencil Sketching Competition

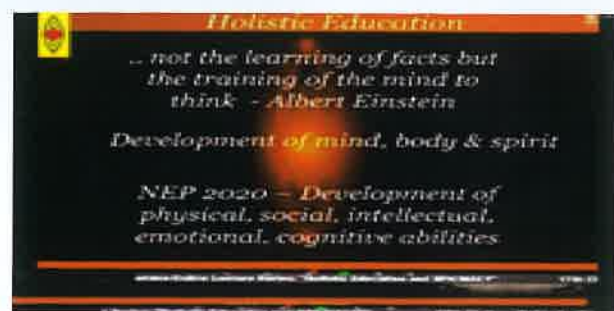
Chethana-Online Lecture series on "Holistic Education and SPICMACAY

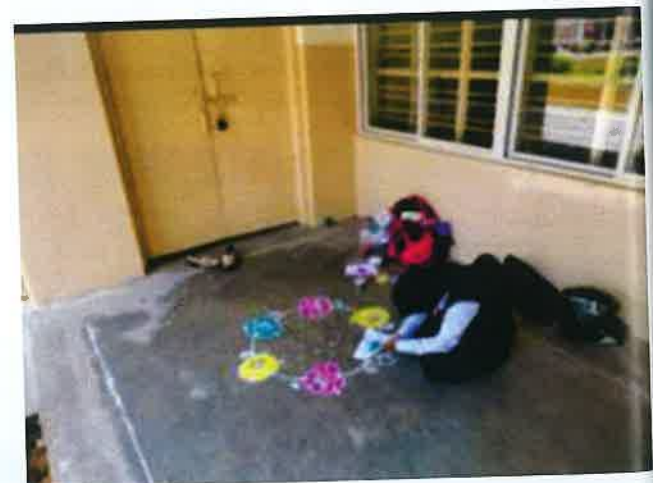

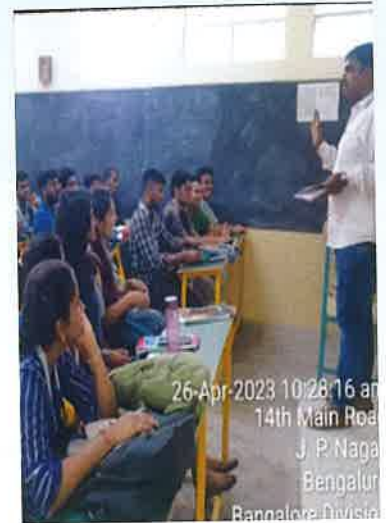
Short Term Course-Training On Business Process Management By NASSCOM

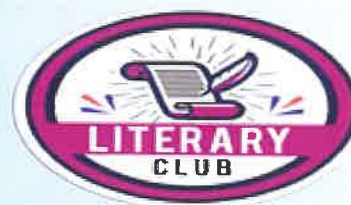

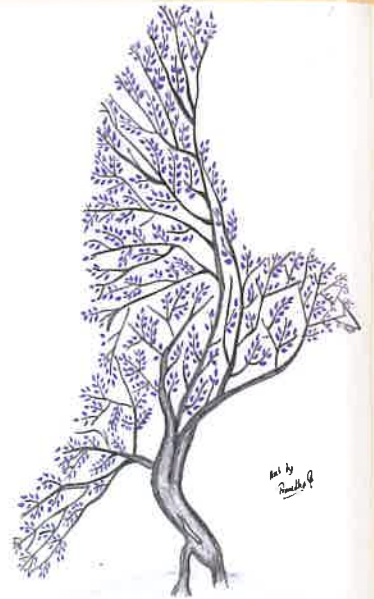

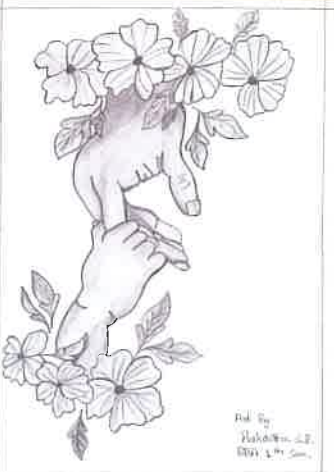
