




### One day workshop on "Neurobics"






### Visit to Akshaya Patra - Experiential learning

A team of 55 entrepreneurs had referral session where each of them announced the business


















### Rangoli Competition








### Voting is a Sacred National Duty - Voting Awareness program


### Workshop on Report Writing








## Inter-collegiate Competition


