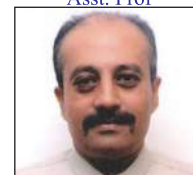

Ms. Gokula Shree M topped the class securing 9.42 GPA in the II Semester examinations with other students securing distinctions and first class.
