ADVANCED RESEARCH METHODOLOGY WORKSHOP

Upholding research values

M.Com faculty and students of II semester of VET First Grade College attended a two day workshop on Advanced Research Methodology on 7th and 8th Sep 2022 on blended mode wherein the resource person for the workshop Dr Vinod Kumar Murti highlighted on the basic concepts of research, variables – categorical and continuous, scales in SPSS – nominal, ordinal, interval and ratio, data quality, sources of data





-primary and secondary, reliability and validity of data and all the basic concepts on research on the first day – the 7th Sep 2022 after the formal inauguration of the event. The second day – 8th Sep 2022 commenced with discussion on hypothesis and then the resource person started with the explanation of null hypothesis, alternative hypothesis, type I error, Type II error, level of significance, test statistics, how to accept or reject the hypothesis, descriptive statistics – comprising of mean, median mode, range, standard deviation, Coefficient of variance, skewness, kurtosis, frequency plot, histogram etc. Then hands on experience on various tests was done through SPSS package.


